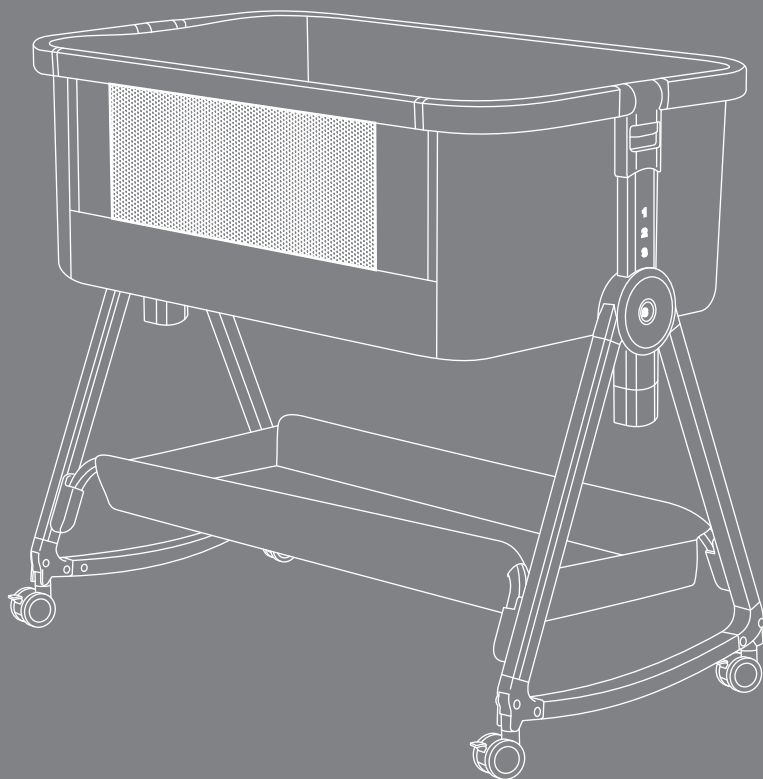

Congratulations on purchasing your new Co-Sleeper.

In almost no time you should be able to have this one of kind co-sleeper ready to meet your beautiful child :)

Please take a few moments to read this instruction manual on how to assemble and use your co-sleeper correctly so you can rest assured that your little one is sleeping safe and Secure.

This Co-Sleeper allows parents to sleep next to their baby without sharing the same bed.

It can be used as a normal crib or as a co-sleeper.

It can be adjusted to 6 different height levels and can be used at an inclined level to help with baby's congestion and reflux.



RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE. READ CAREFULLY BEFORE ASSEMBLING AND USING THE PRODUCT. FOLLOW THE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE SAFE USE OF THE PRODUCT.

- infant should be placed to sleep on a firm, flat surface;
 - place infant on their back when using this product;
 - do not put objects or accessories in an infant's sleep environment;
 - do not place this product near a blind, cord, strap or similar item that could become wrapped around an infant's neck.
 - Do not use this product when the infant begins to push up on their hands and knees or has reached the manufacturers maximum weight of (9 kg), whichever comes first.
- WARNING: check this product regularly before using it, and do not use it if any part is loose or missing or if there are any signs of damage. Do not substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer if replacement parts or additional instructions are needed
- WARNING: Do not use this product without reading the instructions first.
 - WARNING: Placing additional elements in the cot may cause asphyxiation.
 - WARNING: Do not place the product near any other products that could cause a danger of asphyxiation or strangulation, for example: strings, curtains, cords, etc.
 - The assembly elements must always be securely fastened and inspected. This is to ensure they do not collapse and to prevent any of the elements from coming loose. This is important to avoid your child or your child's clothing being trapped and causing strangulation.
 - The crib should always be placed on a horizontal floor.
 - Gaps should not be filled with pillows, blankets or other items.
 - DO NOT let children play near the crib without supervision.
 - When the child is unsupervised in the crib, make sure that the rail is always up, correctly fastened in place and that the zips are fully closed.
 - DO NOT use the product if any of the parts are broken, damaged or missing. Contact LOVE N CARE for replacement parts and extra instructions if necessary.
 - DO NOT use accessories that have not been approved by the manufacturer.
 - Make sure that all of the assembly devices are correctly fitted, as well as the locking devices.
 - Never use the cover without the metal structure.
 - WARNING: To avoid the risk of your child's neck being caught on the top rail next to the adult bed, please ensure this rail is not higher than the adult bed mattress.
 - WARNING: To avoid the risk of strangulation, the attachment system to the adult bed and electrical cable should always be kept out of the crib and out of reach.
 - WARNING: Do not use more than one mattress in the crib.
 - WARNING: To prevent the risk of fire: avoid placing the crib close to a fire or other sources of heat, such as electric or gas heating devices, etc.
 - To avoid the risk of falls and suffocation, never put two or more mattresses in the cot.
 - WARNING: Only use the mattress that comes with the crib.
 - DANGER! Always raise the drop side up completely when the crib is not attached to the adult bed.
 - DO NOT use the crib with following types of adult's beds: -Bedside Crib is designed for use only with adult beds that are between 43 and 58cm from floor to top of adult mattress. The product should not be used as a bedside crib outside of this guide height.
 - WARNING: This bedside sleeper is suitable for a bed with an independent bed edge component, which can be attached with the anchor strap from the bedside sleeper.
 - WARNING: Never add a sleep aid to the crib that is higher than the red line printed on the lining of the crib.
 - WARNING: This product is intended for use for babies aged between 0-6 months, weighing up to a maximum 9 kg
- WARNING: check this product regularly before using it, and do not use it if any part is loose or missing or if there are any signs of damage. Do not substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer if replacement parts or additional instructions are needed.

Before using in "Co-sleeping mode" (Fixed to the bed)" make sure the product is properly anchored and positioned.

The product must always be placed on a horizontal surface. Never leave the product on an inclined surface with the child inside of it.

WARNING: When the product is used in "Co-sleeping mode" (Fixed to the bed)", before laying the child in it, make sure that the connection belts are hooked and tensioned properly, the product must be secured to the parents' mattress and no gaps between the products and the adults' mattress must be present.

Make sure the users of this product are knowledgeable on its proper operation.

Children must not be permitted to play without supervision near the product.

Use only spare parts approved by the manufacturer. Do not apply accessories to the product, which are not supplied by the manufacturer.

Do not adjust or move the product with the child inside.

Do not leave any object inside the product that could reduce its depth.

Do not position the cot near walls and obstacles to prevent trapping hazards.

Do not leave small objects inside the product to prevent choking hazards.

Do not use the product with more than one child at a time.

Do not use the product without the frame.

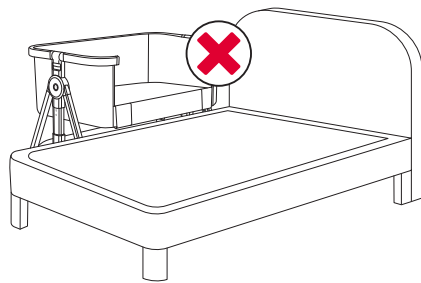
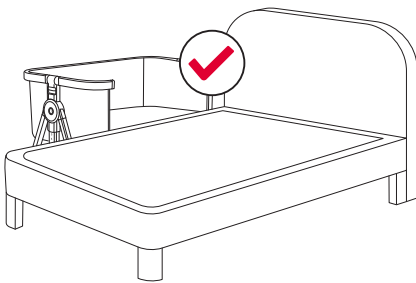
Keep the fastening belts away from the reach of children.

If you purchase a mattress separately, make sure it is suitable for the product.

The product must be kept away from electric cables and cords: do not place the product near windows where cords, curtains or similar objects could pose choking or strangling hazards for the child. To avoid strangling hazards, do not give to your child or place near him, objects equipped with cords.

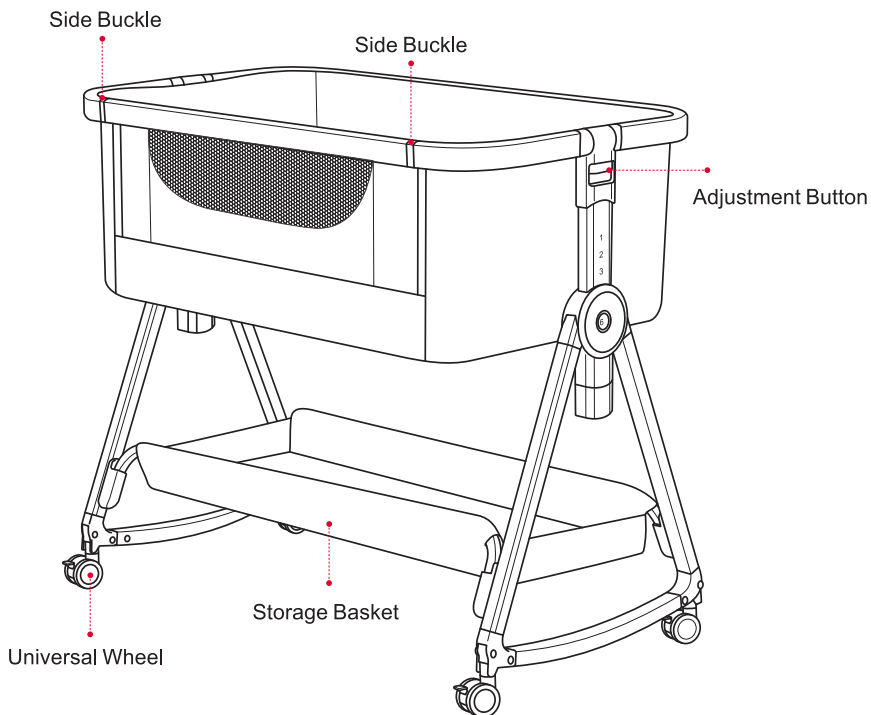
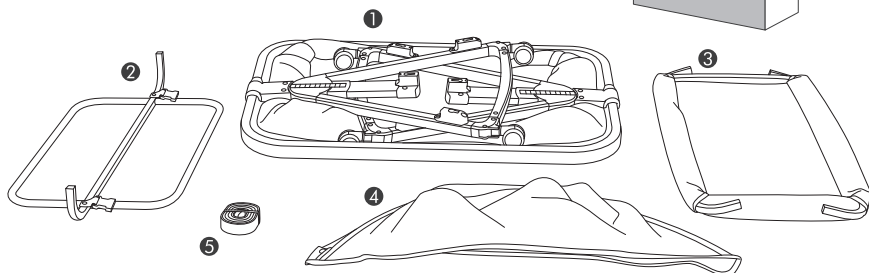
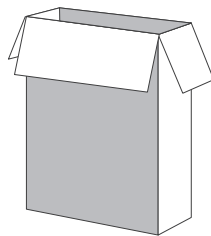
A prolonged exposure to the sun may cause changes of tones to the product's colour. After a prolonged exposure of the product to high temperatures, wait a few minutes prior to placing your child in it.

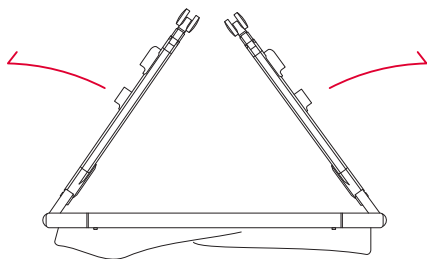

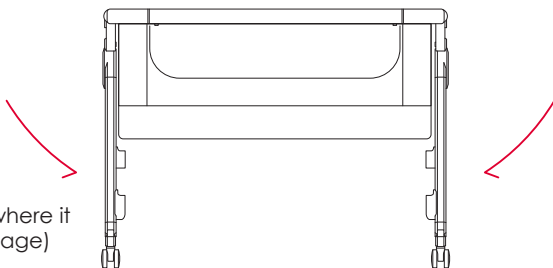

Unfold the Bed Frame

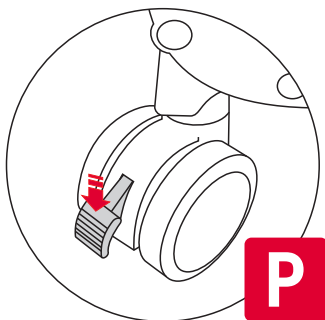
1. Please turn the Foot Tube of the bed to the outside



2. Turn the foot tube to the point where it is vertically upright (as shown in image)



Using the Brakes



To enable the brakes push down on the lever on the wheels on the bottom of the sleeper.



To disable the brakes lift the lever upwards to move the Sleeper.

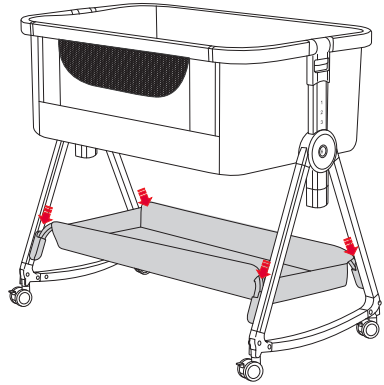

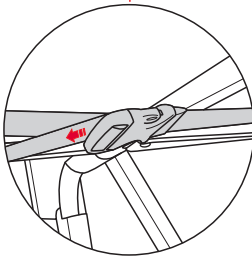
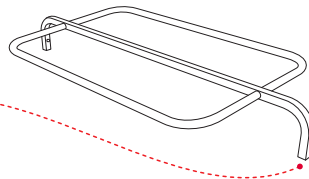
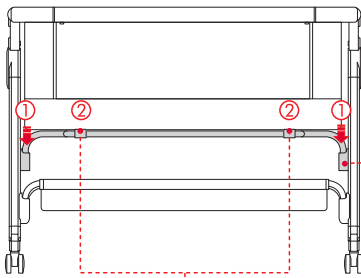
When using the Sleeper ensure the brakes are enabled.

Installing the storage basket

As shown in the image, insert the basket into the foot tubes separately. You should hear a "click" sound indicating they are locked into place.



Installing the bottom bracket



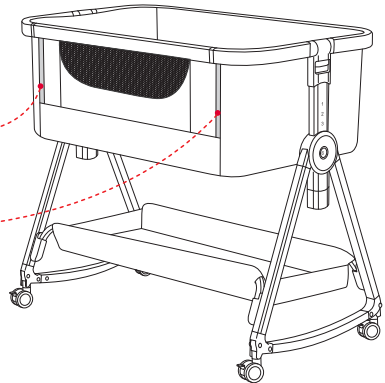
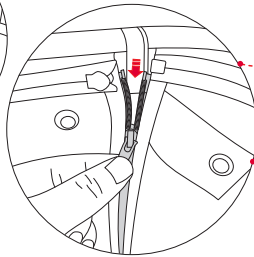
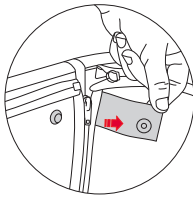
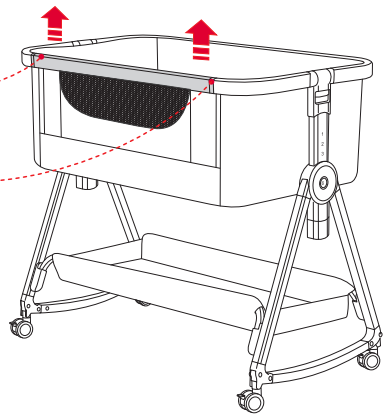
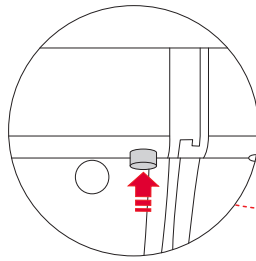
1. Place the two feet of the bottom bracket to the hole on the foot tubes, under the height adjustment rods. A "click" sound indicating they are locked into place.

2. After feet are installed, fix the buckles on the two sides to the middle rod.

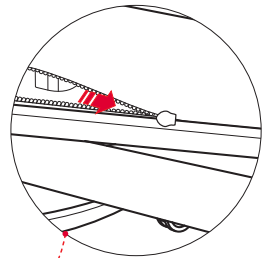
Opening the side frame

Open the Side Frame

1. Press the two detach buttons under the side frame at the same time.

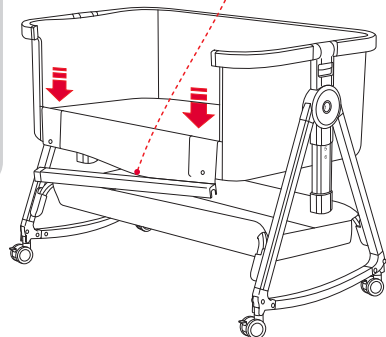


2. Detach the buckle and zipper protector
3. Unzip the 2 zippers on each end.
4. Lift the detached frame up and turn it downward.



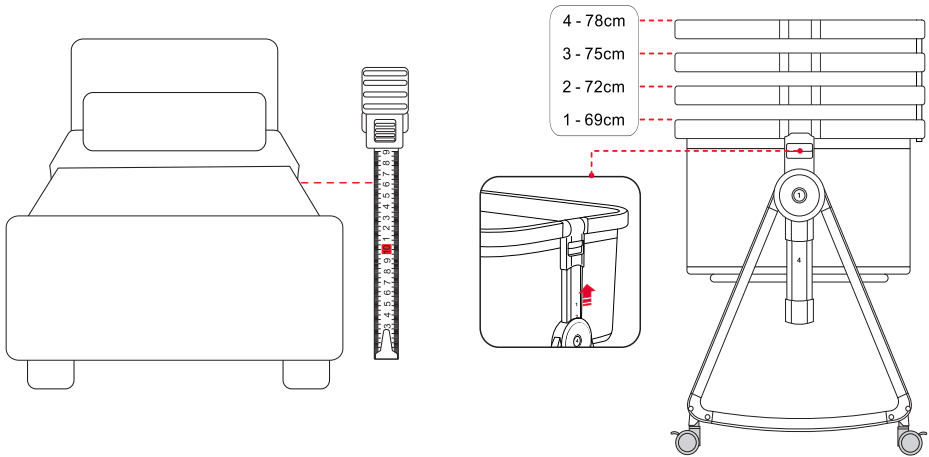
WARNING

Ensure your baby is not inside the crib when you detach the crib from your bed frame.

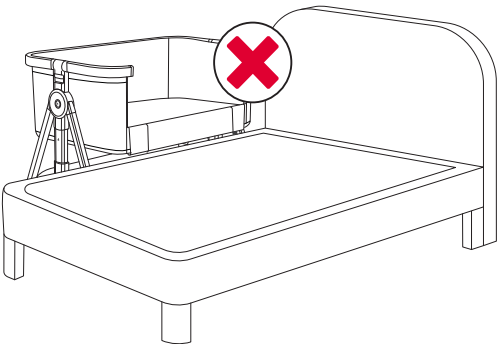
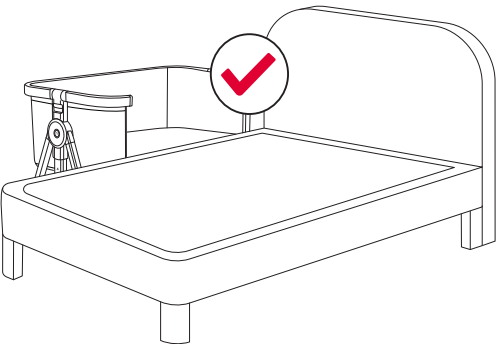


Height Adjustment

Attach to the Bed

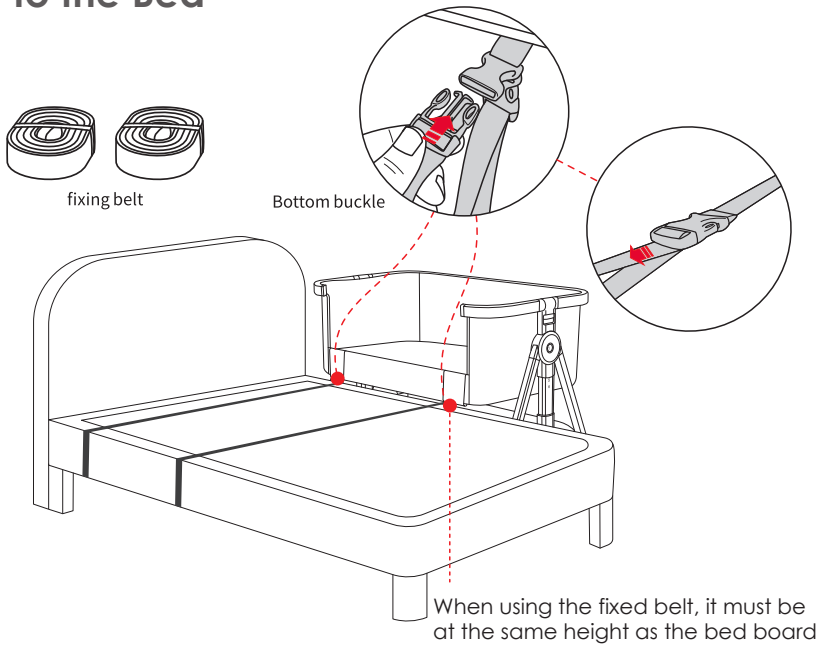


1. Place the bedside crib in a suitable position next to the bed and step on the four wheels brakes.
2. Adjust the height to be level with the bed.



To avoid death from the infants neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adults bed, the top rail must be no higher than the adult mattress. ALWAYS raise the side when not fastened to the adult bed.

Attaching to the Bed



1. Place the bedside sleeper in a suitable position next to the bed and enable all 4 brakes.
2. Adjust the height to be level with the bed.
3. Take out the fixing belt.
4. There are 2 connecting buckles on the bottom frame of the sleeper. Tie the bed with the fixing belt and fasten the buckles to make sure they are secured.



WARNING

Entrapment Hazard - To prevent death from entrapment the sleeper must be properly secured to the adult bed using the attachment straps.

There must be no more than a half inch (13mm) gap between the bedside sleeper and adult bed.

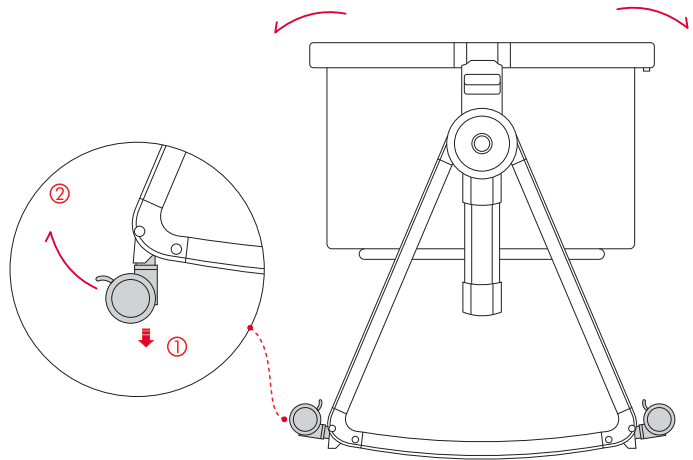
Check the tightness before each use by pulling the bedside sleeper in the direction away from the adult bed.

If the gap exceeds half an inch (13mm), DO NOT use the product.

Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items which can cause a suffocation hazard.

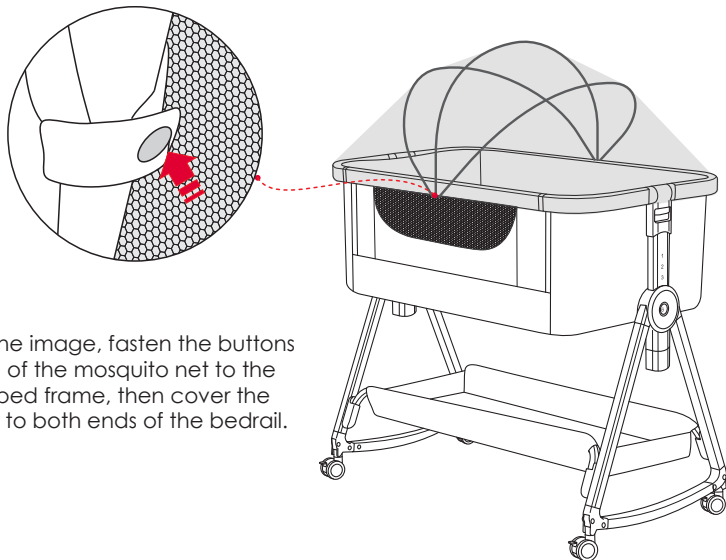
The attachment strap must always be used in bedside sleeper mode.

Cradle Mode



Pull down the four wheels on the sleeper then push them upwards, This will convert the sleeper into a rocking cradle.

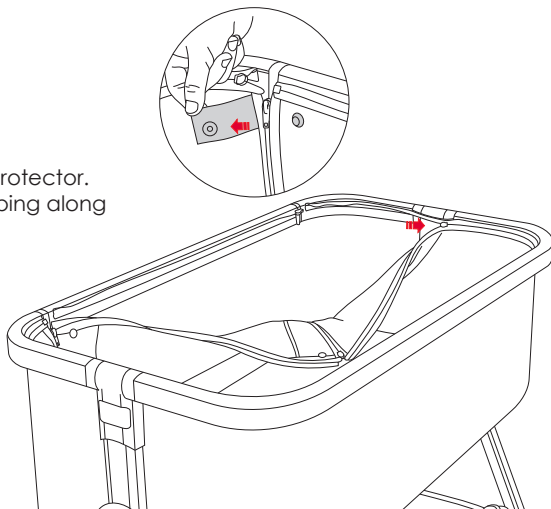
Installing the Mosquito net



As shown in the image, fasten the buttons on both sides of the mosquito net to the inside of the bed frame, then cover the mosquito net to both ends of the bedrail.

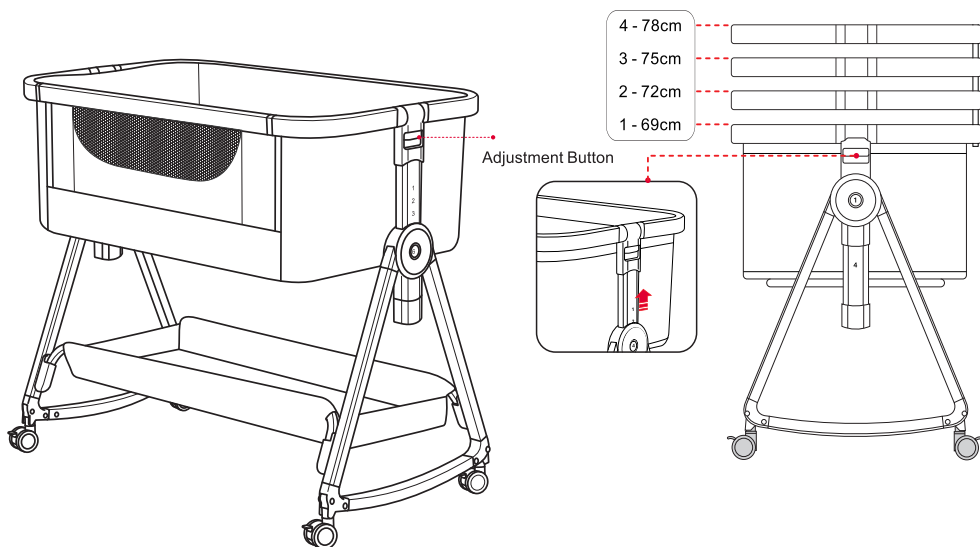
Removing fabric

1. Detach the buckle on the zipper protector.
2. Remove the fabric cover by unzipping along the top edge of the bed frame.



Height Adjustment

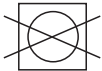
Push up on the adjustment button located on each side of the sleeper and then adjust the level to the desired height level. There are 4 levels. The levels are marked on the side of the sleeper. Make sure each side is at the same level for an even surface.



Care and Maintenance

For washing of the fabric, carefully comply with instructions indicated on the label.

- for cleaning, do not use solvents, abrasive or aggressive products.
- all assembly fittings should always be tightened properly and that care should be taken that no screws are loose, because a child could trap parts of the body or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies' dummies, etc.), which would pose a risk of strangulation.
- from time to time check your bassinet for worn parts, torn material or stitching. Replace or repair the parts as needed. Use only Love N Care parts. Discontinue use if anything is missing.
- excessive exposure to the sun or heat may cause fading or warping of parts.
- It is very important to thoroughly clean and dry the sleeper after using in all seasons.

All Love N Care products are guaranteed for twelve months from the date of purchase. Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law.

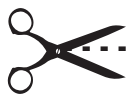
You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage.
