WARNING: TO AVOID INJURY OR DEATH:

FOLLOW THE MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS.

ALWAYS APPLY THE BRAKES WHENEVER THE BASSINET IS STATIONARY.

THE BASSINET MUST BE PLACED ON A FLAT SURFACE.

THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT FOR THE BASSINET IS 9KG

THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT FOR THE BASKET IS 6KG

THE MAXIMUM TOTAL WEIGHT FOR THE BASSINET AND BASKET IS 15KG OR UNTIL THE CHILD CAN SIT UP

It is unsafe to use accessories other than those supplied or approved by Love N Care.

- DISCONTINUE USING THIS BASSINET ONCE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP OR IF A PART IS BROKEN
- USE ONLY THE MATTRESS SUPPLIED BY THE MANUFACTURER.
- INCORRECT MATTRESS CAN CAUSE DEATH
- ENSURE THAT PROPER VENTILATION IS MAINTAINED IN AND AROUND THE BASSINET BY LIMITING PILLOWS, TOYS ETC...
- ENSURE THE BASSINET IS PLACED AT A REASONABLE DISTANCE FROM CURTAINS, BLINDS, HEATERS AND POWER POINTS.
- KEEP MEDICATION, STRING, ELASTIC, SMALL TOYS OR SMALL ITEMS SUCH AS MONEY OUT OF REACH FROM ANY POSITION IN THE BASSINET.

To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.

NEVER add a mattress, pillow, comforter, or padding.

Use ONLY the pad provided by manufacturer. If a sheet is used with the pad, use only the one provided by the bassinet manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the dimension of the bassinet.

WARNING: TO PREVENT SUFFOCATION AND FALLS THE RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE SHOULD BE 370MM WIDE X 800MM LONG AND NO MORE THAN 50MM THICK


HOW TO ASSEMBLE TO OPEN UP THE BASSINET



To open the frame you should pull the frame ends away from each other.

Once they are apart you should ensure that the centre locking is locked by pressing down.

Give it a tug to ensure that it is secure.



HOW TO ASSEMBLE ASSEMBLING THE WHEELS



At the end of the Frame there is an opening to insert the 4 castor wheels.





Once the wheels are secured apply some pressure. You should hear each wheel click into place. Please ensure that all wheels are secured before using.

Pull on the wheels to ensure they don't fall out.





The assembled wheels on the frame should look like this



HOW TO ASSEMBLE ASSEMBLING THE BASKET



Place each press stud around the chrome bars located on four corners.

Wrap each end of the straps around the bar and join the press studs together.





Make sure all 4 press studs are secured before using the basket.

The Assemble basket should look like this.



. The Maximum Weight for the basket is 6kg



HOW TO ASSEMBLE ASSEMBLING THE BASSINET



You must first push the 2 chrome bars (located on the liner) to each end of the board until the liner is raised and the chrome bar end (middle section which sticks out) is placed in the opening on the base. Please ensure that the press studs are faced upwards.

Please ensure that the bars are secured to the openings by giving it a slight tug. If this is not secured, the bassinet will not stabilize.





Once the bars are inserted to the base you must then secure each of the press studs which are attached on the liner to the studs located on the base.

Each of the press studs should be pressed together. Pull on the liner slightly to ensure all are secured to the liner.

The assembled bassinet should look like this.



HOW TO ASSEMBLE ASSEMBLING THE BASSINET



Place the bassinet on the top of the stand. Ensure that the two chrome bars are placed in the outward position.

The Bassinet should lay flat on the top of the frame between the bars.





Make sure that the material located on the bottom of the bassinet which has press studs is able to wrap around the frame. Wrap the Material around the frame and click the press studs to the Base. Repeat this on both sides to secure the bassinet. Tug on the bassinet to ensure it is stable








HOW TO ASSEMBLE ASSEMBLING THE HOOD



Place the sides of the bassinet into the holders located on each of the sides of the bassinet frame. Push in the centre until it clicks into place. Repeat for both sides. Pull on it slightly to make sure it is secured.

Once the sides are clicked into place, snap the clips to the buttons located on the sides. They should click into place.





HOW TO USE

INSERTING MATTRESS, PILLOW, QUIIT AND MOSQUITO NET











Once the bassinet has been assembled you must place the bassinet mattress in first then the quilt and then the pillow.

Place the mosquito net on the top of the bassinet. Make sure that the elastic mosquito net is place around the bassinet line and around the hood.

HOW TO USE

Brakes





To apply the brakes push the on the end of each wheel downwards. Repeat this on all sides. After placing the child inside the bassinet it is recommended to apply the brakes on all wheels.

To release the brakes push the lever upwards. In order to move the bassinet from one place to another release the brakes.



HOW TO FOLD



You must first release the press studs which are holding the bassinet to the frame



Remove the mattress, quilt and pillow from the bassinet. You can remove the press studs if you would like to wash the liner bus it is not necessary to remove the liner here. Release the 2 chrome bars from the base by raising them up.



The bassinet should now be flat.





Next we can remove the basket from the frame. Release the press studs from the frame.

Raise up the middle section of the frame and push the two frame ends to close the frame.

THE STAND CAN BE CLEANED WITH A DAMP CLOTH.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

Bassinet and canopy:

Hand wash, warm (50°C). Wash separately. Use bleach-free detergent. Do not iron. Do not dry clean. Do not tumble dry.



Mattress cover and pillow:

Hand wash (50°C). Use bleach-free detergent. Do not dry clean. Do not Iron. Do not tumble dry.



Warranty against defects
