▲ WARNINGS

- Follow the manufacturer's instructions.
- Put on all the brakes whenever you park the stroller.
- Always apply the brakes whenever the stroller is stationary.
- Do not leave children unattended.
- Secure the child in the harness at all times.
- Do not carry extra children or bags on this stroller.
- Do not use this seat with any other models of stroller.
- Do not use this bassinet once the child can sit up unaided.
- Use the seat in the upright once this occurs.
- Make sure children are clear of any moving parts if you adjust stroller, otherwise they may be injured.
- Use the harness at all times.
- When not in use disconnect shoulder straps from the waist strap and/or buckle.
- The harness can form loops which may be a strangulation hazard.
- Never leave a harness connected when not fitted to a child in the stroller.
- To avoid serious injury always use the harness provided to secure the child. (adjust the straps to suit the size of your child's body)
- It is unsafe to use accessories other than those supplied by vulu.
- Care should be taken if the stroller is to be used on stairs or escalators.
- This stroller should not be used near an open fire or an exposed flame.
- Care should be taken whilst folding and unfolding the stroller to prevent fingers being trapped.
- Ensure your child's fingers, hands and all other body parts are clear from any moving parts when adjusting the seat or handle on your stroller.
- Make sure that the stroller is fully unfolded and locked into position before placing your child inside.
- To avoid the risk of suffocation keep all plastic packaging and materials out of reach of children.
- Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.
- Always ensure that that your child is clear of moving parts before you adjust the position of the backrest or hood.
- When in use as bassinets do not place a mattress thicker than 10mm.
- Use in seat mode as soon as your child can sit up unaided.
- The product will become unstable if the manufacturer's recommended load is exceeded.
- This product is not suitable for running or skating.
- Always use the crotch strap in combination with the waist belt.
- Avoid serious injury from falling or sliding out. Always use the harness.
- The seat is suitable for newborns.

▲ WARNINGS

- Check the safety of the Vulu Stroller before each use. Ensure that the seat fabric, the brake and the harness are all working properly, the handlebar is locked and that the seat is fitted correctly to the chassis.
- Take your child out of the stroller when going up or down stairs and around steep or unstable conditions. Also, take extra care when going up or down a curb or other uneven surfaces.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD:

- In gaps between an extra pad and the side of the bassinet.
- On soft bedding. NEVER add a mattress, pillow, comforter, or padding. Use ONLY the pad provided by manufacturer.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, paediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- The seat is not intended for prolonged periods of sleeping.

MAXIMUM WEIGHT WHEN USED IN BASSINET MODE: 9KG (SUITABLE FOR NEWBORN) WHEN USED IN SEAT POSITION MAX WEIGHT IS : 22KG

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

maintenance

All Vulu products have one year warranty from the date of purchase. After a few months of using your stroller it may get a bit dirty from usage. These tips will help you take care of your Vulu Stroller and keep it running smoothly.

- Clean the frame with a soft towel and lukewarm water and wipe off any remaining water with a dry cloth.
- Use a soft brush to clean sand and dirt from the mechanisms. Take care to brush away from any sliding joints.
- Use a sponge, warm water and liquid soap to gently rub off any dirt on the handlebar. Wipe clean any soap residue left on the handlebar.
- Use a brush and water to clean dirt on the wheels. Periodically, remove the wheels from the frame and brush off any dirt or sand in the inside axle of the wheel.
- Store your stroller and its accessories in a dry place and leave them unfolded when wet to prevent mould.

cleaning care

The Vulu Stroller bassinet and seat fabrics are detachable and machine washable. When washing don't forget:

- maximum temperature 30°C/85°F (cold wash)
- do not use bleach or aggressive detergents
- do not tumble dry
- do not iron
- do not dry clean
- always wash separately



WARRANTY AGAINST DEFECTS

All love n care/Vulu products are guaranteed for twelve months from the date of purchase. Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian consumer law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced

If the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure. This covers against faults which develop through faulty materials and workmanship. Misuse, accidental damages, normal wear and tear or neglect are not covered.

If a fault becomes apparent, please return the item to the store of purchase with your receipt. You must inform the store what the defect is. 







unfolding the frame

1. pull the latch upwards to release the stroller from being locked.

2. pull the handle upwards and the bottom and the top of the stroller should move towards their stable positions.

3. once you have pulled up as much as you can the stroller should click into position. Pull on the stroller to ensure that it is stable.

attaching and removing the rear wheels

1. place the rear wheel axel (k) on the back of the frame. Push the buttons in on the back of the frame and slide the axel (k)into its place. The holes on the axel (k) should line up with the button on the frame. Push the axel (k) downwards. The axel (k) should click into place.

2. place one of the rear wheels (j) onto the rear axel (k). push the wheel towards the axel. it should click into place.

3. repeat for the other side.

4. to remove the rear wheel (j) press the button on the centre of the rear wheel and pull the wheel off the axel. repeat for both sides.

attaching and removing the front wheels

1. place the front wheel (i) onto the front spokes on the front of the frame. push the wheel upwards and press the button on the holders to make sure that the wheel clicks into place.

2. when the front wheel (i) is attached properly it should click into place. repeat this for both wheels.

3. to remove the front wheel (i) press the release button located on the bottom holders of the frame.

attaching the basket

1. loop the end of the basket (c) around the front strap of the frame. Once the end of the basket is looped over the straps, feed. Make sure the 3 velcro straps are used for all locations.

2. loop the sides of the basket (c) around the sides of the frame. Once the sides of the basket are looped over the joint, push the press studs together to snap them in to place. Repeat for the other side.

3. The assembled basket should look like this.

4. The baskets has a strap which uou can open and close using the draw string. Push on the cord to release.

assembling the bassinet

1. you will first need to identify the top of the bassinet seat. (with the recline handle) Place the liner around the seat frame until it covers the whole of the frame.

2. Zip the liner around the frame to make sure that assembled to the frame.

3. The assembled bassinet to the frame should look like this.

4. Plase the bassinet Base (f) onto the assembled bassinet. Make sure that the four holders are pointed downwards.

5. The assembled bassinet with the base (f) should look like this.

6. Place the bassinet mattress (g) onto the top of the bassinet onto the top of the base board.

7. attached the bassinet bar into the holders located one each of the sides of the bassinet frame.

8. Place the bassinet boot cover (m) over the top of the bassinet and and press the cover to the frame where the press studs are located to attach it to the bassinet.

adding the bassinet to the frame

1. align the bottom of the assembled bassinet with the holders on the frame. make sure that the top of the bassinet is towards the front wheels. slot the assembled bassinet and it should click into place.

2. the bassinet on the frame should have the head of the toddler above the front wheels and the legs towards the rear wheels. the baby should always be visible at all times whilst in bassinet mode.

3. place the bassinet hood (L) on the top half of the bassinet. this is the position just above the bassinet bar. the ends of the hood should snap onto the sides of the bassinet. pull on it slightly to ensure it is secured on correctly. Make sure that the innerside of the hood (canopy) is towards the frame and the outer side of the canopy is towards the front of the bassinet or seat.

4. this is the correctly assembled bassinet on the stroller. please note the position of the bassinet and the hood. do not use the bassinet in the opposite position.

adding the bootcover to the seat.

 place the seat boot cover (o) around the bottom edge of the seat frame.
connect the press studs from the boot cover (o) sides to those studs located on either side of the seat frame.

3. loop the top of the bootcover (o) around the installed bar and connect the press stud from the end of the cover to the stud on the fron of the cover.

4. The installed boot cover should look like this.

assembling the seat

1. slide the seat liner (h) over the seat frame (b). place the top of the liner over the front of the seat frame.

2. pull the strap from the seat liner around the bar and slot it into the rivets located on each side of the frame. repeat for both sides. please note the rivets are only located on the bottom of seat frame. Use the velcro straps from the sides of the liner and strap them around the frame

3. use the velcro straps from the bottom of the liner and strap them around the frame. repeat for all velcro straps.

4. connect the straps behind the seat liner together as shown. tighten the straps to make sure that the liner is tight around the frame. to release the connector push the sides inwards to release.

5. Place the seat inner liner (p) over the harness straps.

6. place the seat bar (d) into the holders located on each side of the seat frame. they should click into place.

7. the assembled bar (d) should look like this.

8. place the seat hood (L) on the top half of the seat. this is the position just above the seat bar. the ends of the hood should snap onto the sides of the seat. Pull on it slightly to ensure it is secured on correctly. The outerside of the canopy(hood) should be towards the front of the seat and the innerside to the frame.

9. the fully assembled seat liner on the frame should look like this.

attaching the seat to the frame

1. align the bottom of the assembled seat with the holders on the frame. slot the assembled seat in the direction desired and it should click into place. push down on the seat to ensure that it is secured in position.

2. the seat can be either in the forward facing position for toddlers.

3. or the seat can be in the rearward facing position for newborns.

removing the seat from the frame

to remove the the seat or bassinet from the frame, press the release button located on the frame, under the seat or bassinet and then lift the seat out of the holders.

using the hood

1. the hood can be attached to the seat (see attachment of hood steps). the hood can be moved either forwards or backwards.

2. to use the hood pull the front of the hoods in the direction required depending on the position of the seat.

3. to close the hood push the hood towards the back of the seat or bassinet.

4. the hood(Canopy) can be adjusted to various positions as suited.

adjusting the backrest

On the top of the seat there are large handle button to adjust the seating position of the seat. in order to adjust the backrest pull the button located on the top of the seat and push the seat backwards or forwards depending on the desired position. It is recommended to have the seat reclined as much as possible for newborns until they can support themselves in the upright position.

adjusting the handle and tether strap

1. there are two circle buttons located on the handle of the stroller. each button is located on the sides of the handle.

2. depress each of the buttons on the side and push the handle downwards if that is the desired position. to return it to its original position press each of the buttons and push the handle upwards.

3.



Place the tether strap around the stroller and tighten to the handle. Please ensure that your hand is looped in tether strap at all times whilst stroller is in operation. 4. use the tether strap to stop the stroller rolling away. place your hand through the loop and grab the top of the handle with your hand.

using the brakes and adjusting the front wheels

1.

WARNING: TO AVOID INJURY OR DEATH: ALWAYS APPLY THE BRAKES WHENEVER THE STROLLER IS STATIONARY.

when the stroller becomes stationary you should apply the brakes located on the rear axel of the stroller. to engage the brakes push the levers on the axel downwards with your foot. to release the brakes push the levers on the axel upwards with your foot.

2. to lock the front wheels of the stroller in the straight position push the lever located on the front wheel holders. turn the wheel until it clicks into position. the wheels should lock into the one direction. repeat for both wheels.

3. to make the front wheels all swivel push the lever upwards. the wheels should now be able to move in all directions.

using the harness

familiarise yourself with all components of the 5 point harness.

1. place the child into the stroller seat and place the shoulder straps over the childs shoulders. adjust the sliders until they are tight enough to keep the child in the seat. repeat for both shoulder straps.

2. on the bottom of the shoulder strap is a hook that will need to be inserted into the hole on the waist strap.

3. adjust the waist strap slider to ensure that the harness fit around the child. insert the hook from the shoulder strap into the hole located on the top of the waist strap buckle. the hook should then click into place. repeat for both sides. 4. make sure that the child is comfortably seated in the stroller. then make sure that the shoulder strap is over the shoulder of the toddler and around its waist on each side. bring the assembled shoulder/waist straps into the housing buckle located on the crotch strap. the straps can only fit in one way. the straps should click into place if inserted correctly. pull on them slightly to ensure they are inserted correctly.

5. to remove the child from the harness press the round button located on the housing buckle and remove the shoulder /waist strap. push the hook from the shoulder strap with your fingers to remove from the hole on the waist strap. the child should them be removed from the seat.

6 this is a fully assembled harness.

folding the stroller

1. please ensure that the seat/bassinet is removed from the frame before folding the stroller. there is a release button on the handle of the stroller. It is located on the right hand side of the handle. whilst pressing the release button push the lever on the opposite side in the upwards positions. this should release the stroller from the locked position.

2. once the joints are released push the stroller in the downwards position.

3. once the stroller is compact please ensure that the secondary locking mechanism is engaged. this is to make sure that the stroller does not open unexpectedly. you can also adjust the handle of the stroller further if you need to.
