Congratulations on purchasing your new 3-in1 Cosmos Crib. In almost no time you should be able to have this one of kind crib ready to meet your beautiful child:)

Please take a few moments to read this instruction manual on how to assemble and use your co-sleeper correctly so you can rest assured that your little one is sleeping Safe and Secure.

This 3-In-1 Crib can be used as a normal crib, rocker or as a playard. The Crib can convert to a Playard with the release of the zipper, it also can become a rocker with the turning of its legs.











RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE. READ CAREFULLY BEFORE ASSEMBLING AND USING THE PRODUCT

- THE COT IS INTENDED FOR USE FOR CHILDREN AGED: between birth up to 24 months.
- WARNING: When the mattress base is in the highest position the cot is designed for use by children of 0-6 months (weighing up to 9kg). When a child is able to sit, kneel or to pull themselves up, the lowest mattress position is the safest.
- WARNING: Before using in crib mode (higher bed base) make sure that the zip is completely closed and secured with the buckle.
- WARNING: To prevent the risk of fire, do not place the cot near fans. Electric bar fires, gas fires or other sources of heat.
- WARNING: Do not use the cot if any parts are broken, ripped or missing, and only use spare parts approved by the manufacturer.
- WARNING: Do not leave anything in the cot or place it close to another product that can be leant on or that could represent a choking or strangling hazard, such as ropes, cables, curtain cords etc.
- WARNING: Do not use more than one mattress in the cot.
- WARNING: Only use the mattress sold together with this cot. Do not add a second mattress above this one due to a risk of suffocation.
- Infants can suffocate on soft bedding .Avoid placing and pillow or similar items under sleeping infant for additional comfort.
- Do not adjust the height of the cot when the child is in it.
- The cot is ready for use only when the locking mechanisms are engaged . Make sure they are securely fixed before using the cot.
- The lowest position of the bed base is the safest. The base should be moved to this position as soon as the baby is old enough to sit up.
- All components must be correctly secured. Connections must be regularly checked and tightened ,if necessary
- When the child is able to climb over the sides to get out of the cot, this cot is no longer suitable for them.
- All opening and adjustment operations and the installation of accessories must be carried out by an adult.
- Before using always check that both sides of the cot are securely in place and that the cot opening mechanism engaged, as illustrated in the instructions.
- Do not move the product when the child is in the cot.
- Do not place more than one child at a time in the cot.
- Do not let other children play unattended close to the cot.
- Do not place the cot on to a sloped surface with your child inside.
- To prevent it becoming trapped, do not place the cot close to walls or obstacles.
- The cot must be kept away from electrical cables and cords: do not position close to windows where cords, curtains or similar could pose a suffocation or choking hazard. To avoid all risks of strangulation, never give children objects with cords or strings attached, or leave them within their reach. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause the colours of the fabric to fade .After a prolonged exposure of the product to high temperatures, wait a few minutes prior to putting your child in it.

- Make sure the users of this product are knowledgeable on its proper operation.
- Children must not be permitted to play without supervision near the product.
- Use only spare parts approved by the manufacturer. Do not apply accessories to the product, which are not supplied by the manufacturer.
- Do not adjust the product with the child inside.
- Do not move the product with the child inside.
- Do not leave any object inside the product that could reduce its depth.
- Do not position the cot near walls and obstacles to prevent trapping hazards.
- Do not leave small objects inside the product to prevent choking hazards.
- Do not use the product with more than one child at a time.
- Do not use the product without the frame.
- If you purchase a mattress separately, make sure it is suitable for the product.
- A prolonged exposure to the sun may cause changes of tones to the product's colour. After a prolonged exposure of the product to high temperatures, wait a few minutes prior to placing your child in it.
- When not in use, keep the product away from the reach of children.
- Do not close the cot when the child is in it.
- Keep the product out of reach of children when it is not in use. When crib at the highest position, the height of the inside of the crib at least 200MM.
- The crib/cradle should be placed on a horizontal floor;
- Young children should not be allowed to play unsupervised in the vicinity of a crib /cradle.
- Discontinue using the product if damaged and contact Love N Care for assistance.


Unfold the legs

IDENTIFY THE FOUR LEGS ON THE JOINTS

STEP 2:



OPEN THE LEGS #2 THEN OPEN THE LEGS#1

STEP 3:



MAKE SURE ALL JOINTS ARE FULL ENGAGED

Folding the crib



IDENTIFY THE NUMBER ON THE FOUR LEGS ON THE JOINTS
STEP ON THE ROCKING TUBE AND PULL THE RAIL UPWARDS
RELEASE LEGS #1 AND THEN FOLD THE LEGS #1 INTERNALLY,
RELEASE LEGS #2 AND THEN FOLD THE LEGS #2 INTERNALLY

DELUXE FOAM MATTRESS INCLUDED

Rotate the rocking bar outwards to change the crib to rocking function .

To return back to stand alone tube ,lift the legs a little bit , then rotate the rocking bar internally.




CAN BE USED AS A PLAYARD

Unzip the mattress and then put the it to the bottom and change to playard mode.






