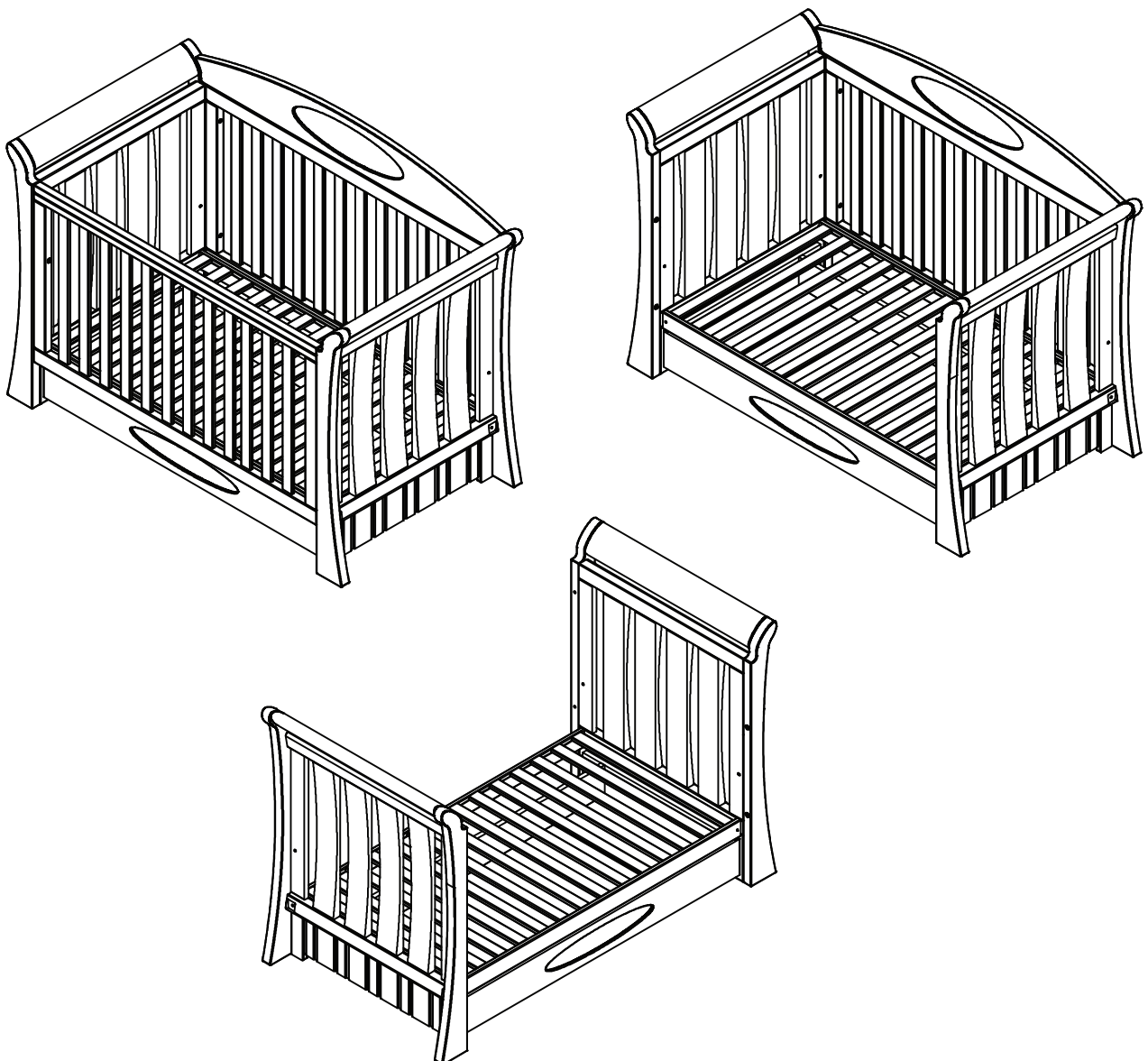

WARNING

This cot has been designed for a child up to 25kg

Do not leave your child unattended when the dropside is in the lower position

RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE: This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measure 760mm wide by 1310mm long and 130mm in thickness.

The width and length are specific because it is important that the gaps between the mattress and the sides and ends of the cot will not exceed 40mm. This is to minimize the risk of a child's limb becoming caught in the gap. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than 500mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimise the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

WARNING TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MATTRESS BASE OF THIS COT SHOULD BE ADJUSTED TO THE LOWEST POSITION BEFORE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP.

The manufacturer's assembly instructions must be followed in detail to ensure all the safety features of the cot are not compromised.

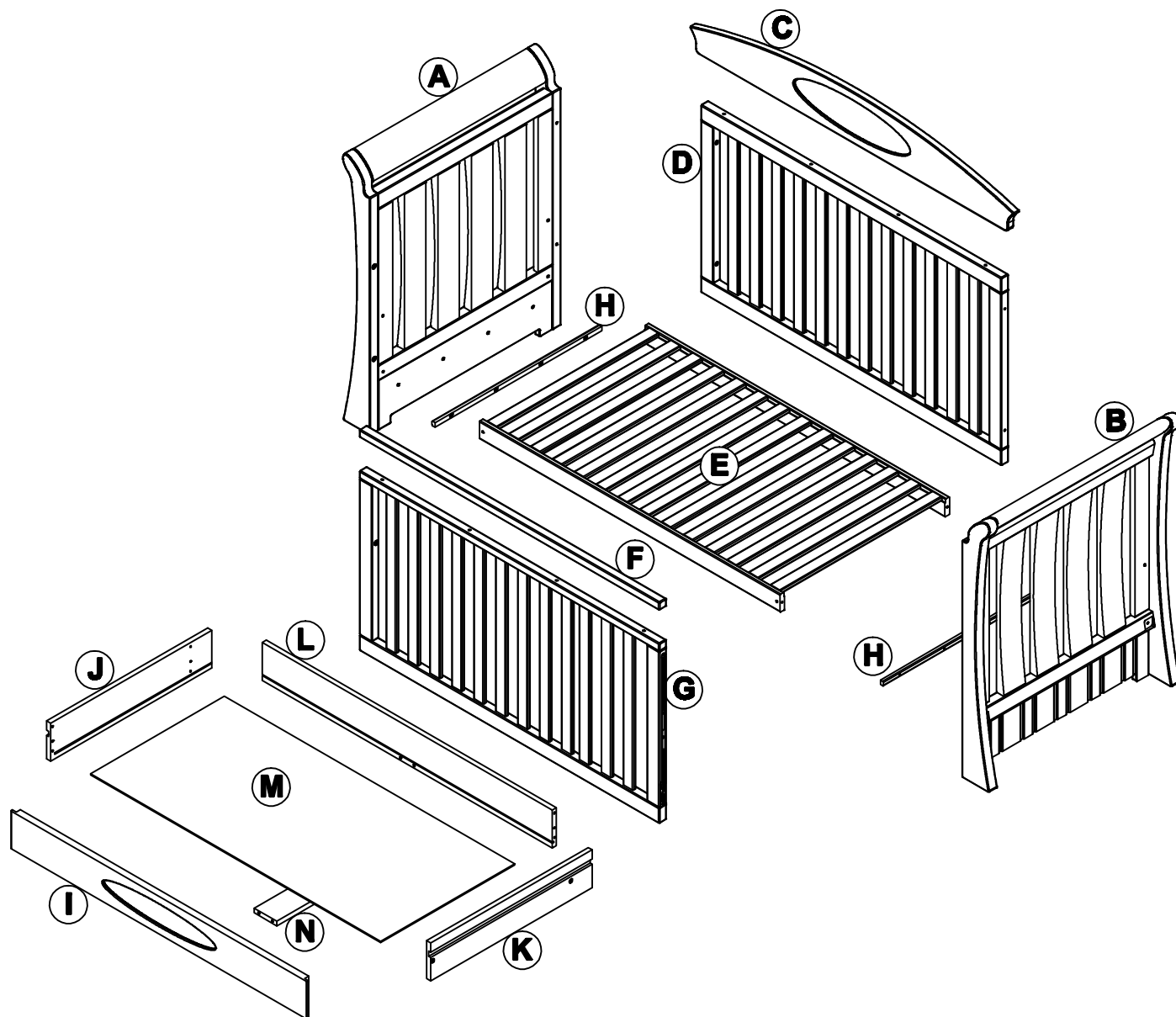
Please ensure that the cot is placed at a reasonable distance from curtains, blinds, heaters and power points.

Please keep medication, string, elastic, small toys or small items, such as money out of reach from any position in the cot.



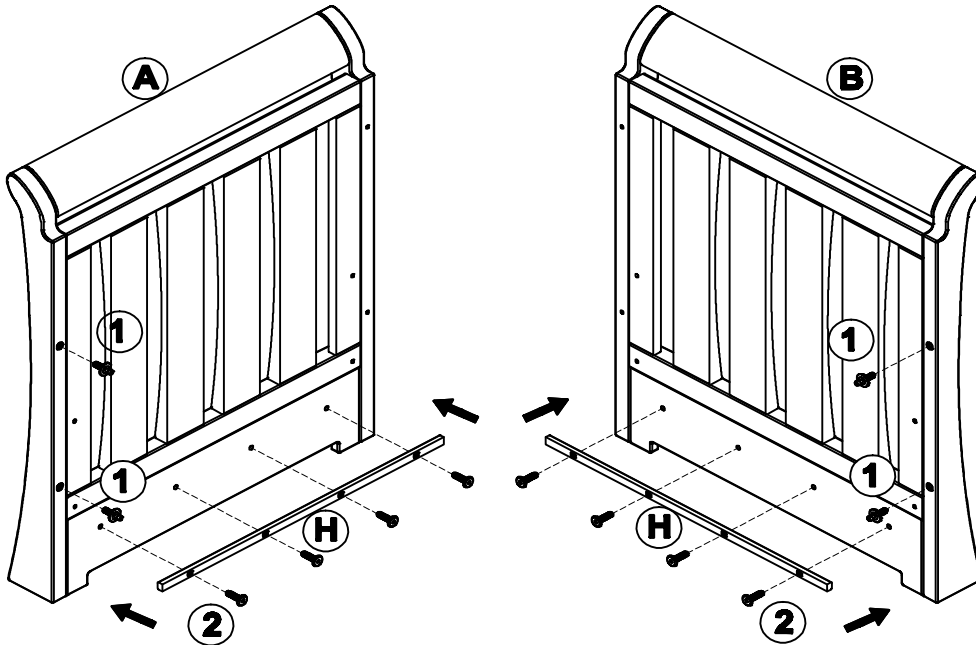

1. Attach 4pcs Nails (1) to Left End (A) and Right End (B).

2. Attach 2pcs Support Rails (H) to Left End (A) and Right End (B), using 8pcs Bolts (2) with Allen Key (11).

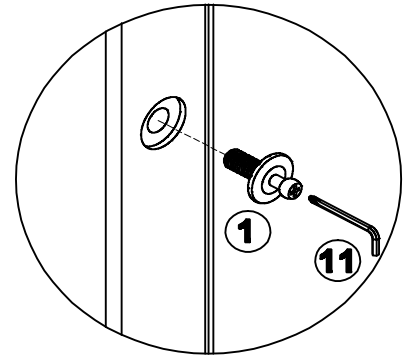

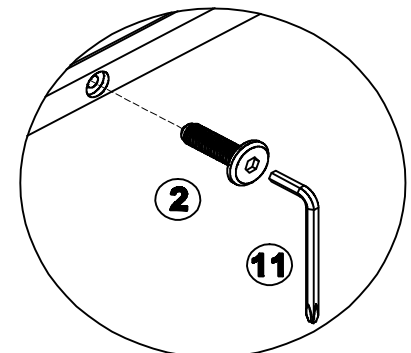

Step2 ASSEMBLING THE DROPSIDE

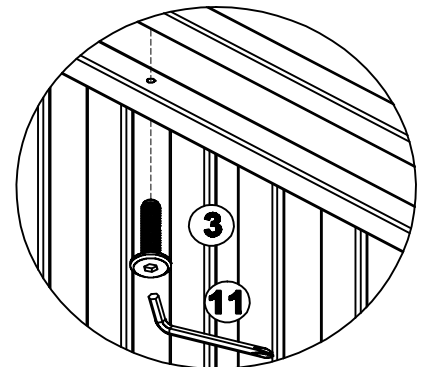
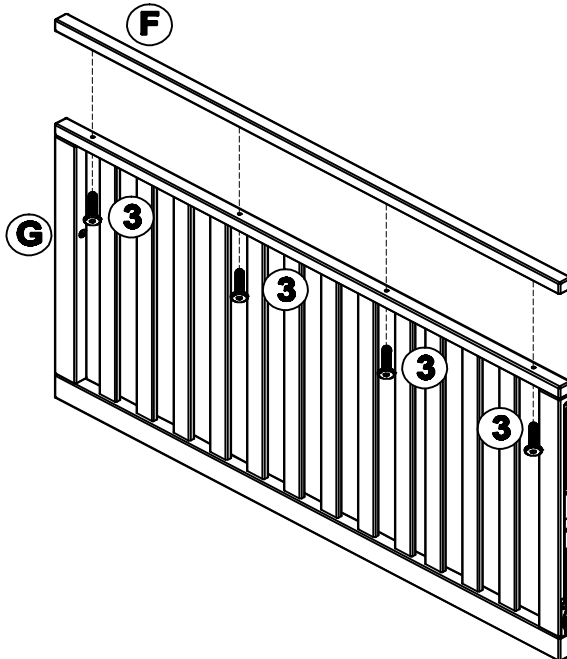


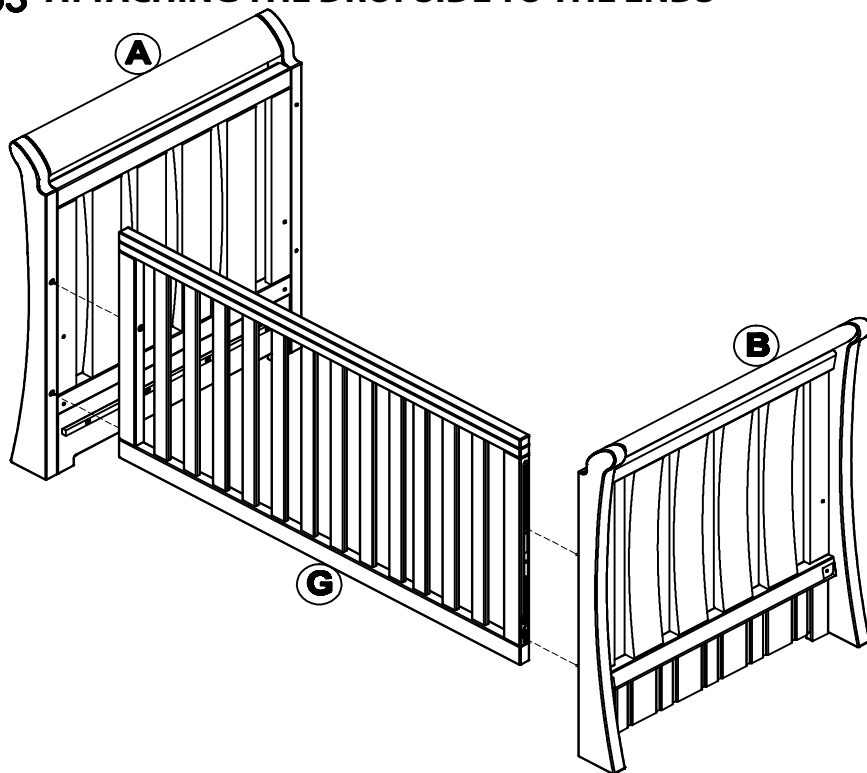

See Figure 4&5.

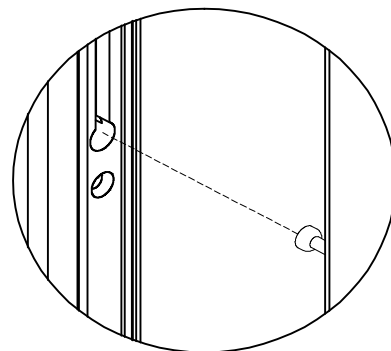

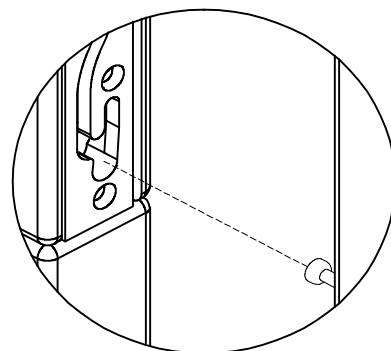
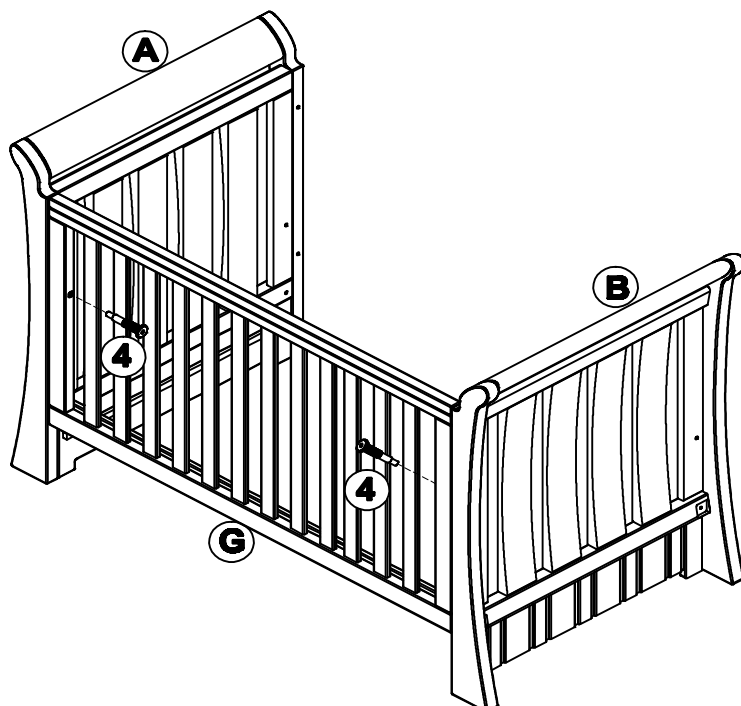

See Figure 6.

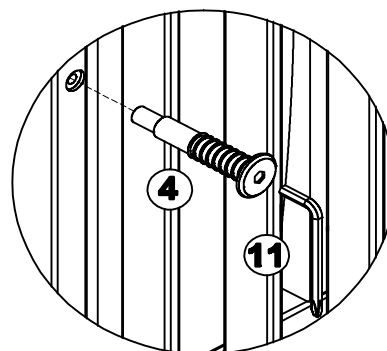

ATTACHING THE BASE TO THE ENDS AND DROPSIDE

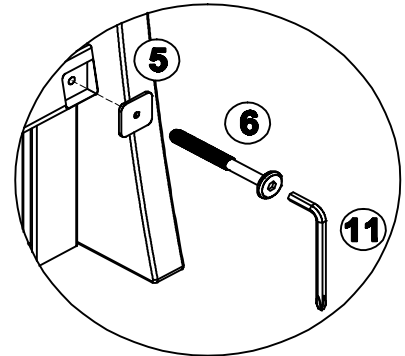
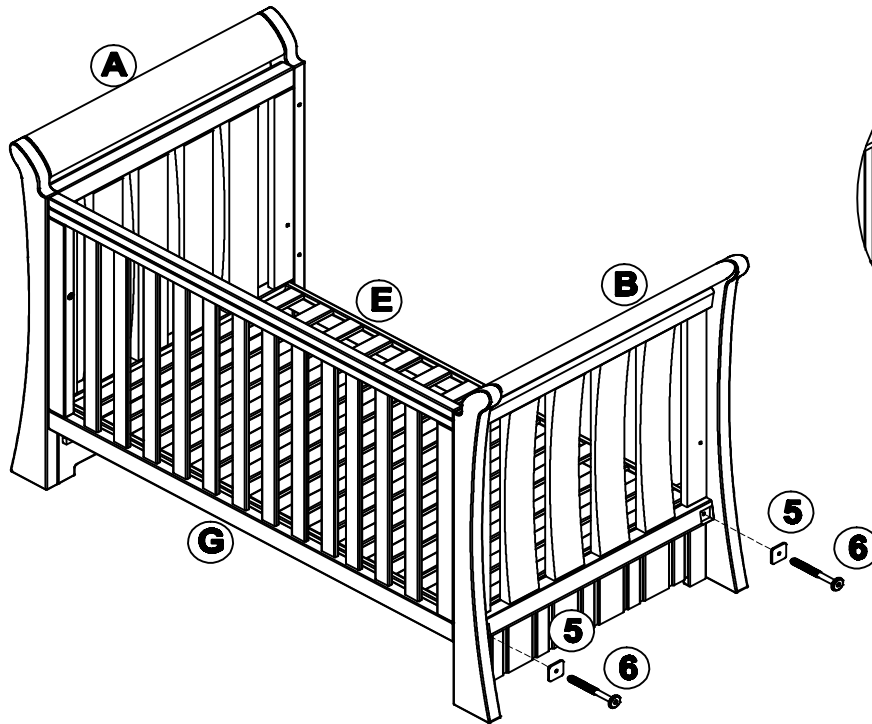

ASSEMBLING THE FIXED SIDE

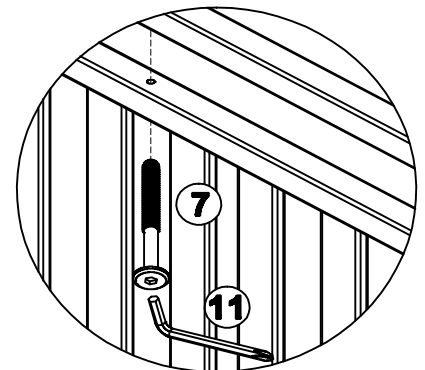
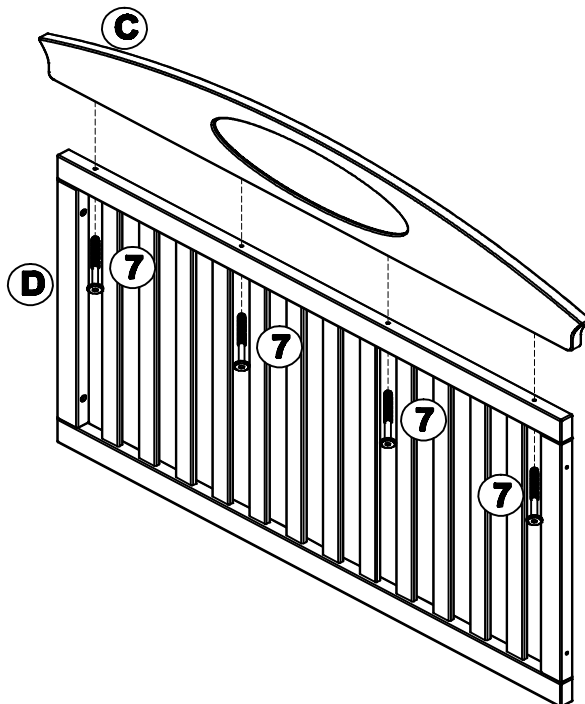

Step7 ATTACHING FIXED SIDE

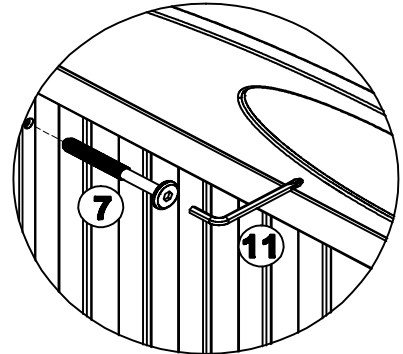
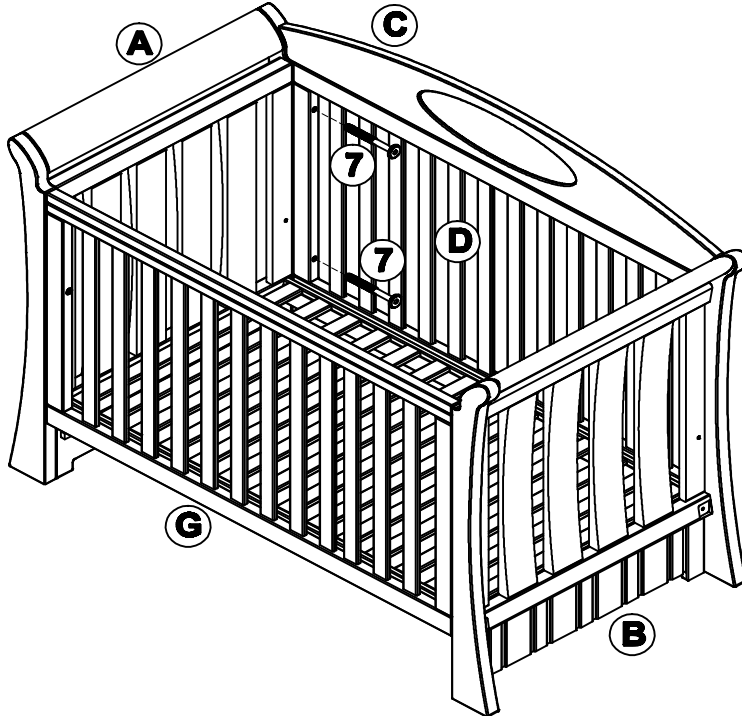

Step8 ASSEMBLING THE DRAWER

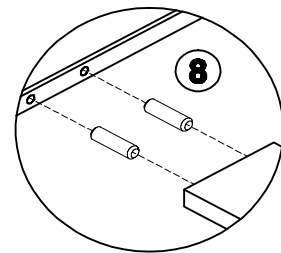
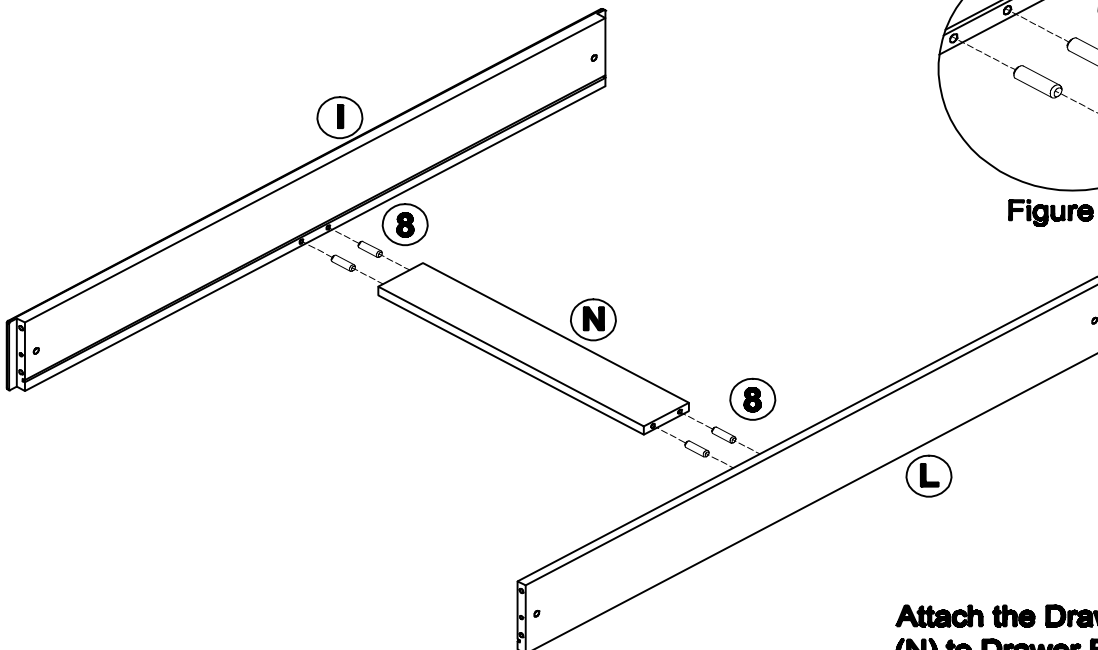

Step9 ATTACHING ENDS IN DRAWER

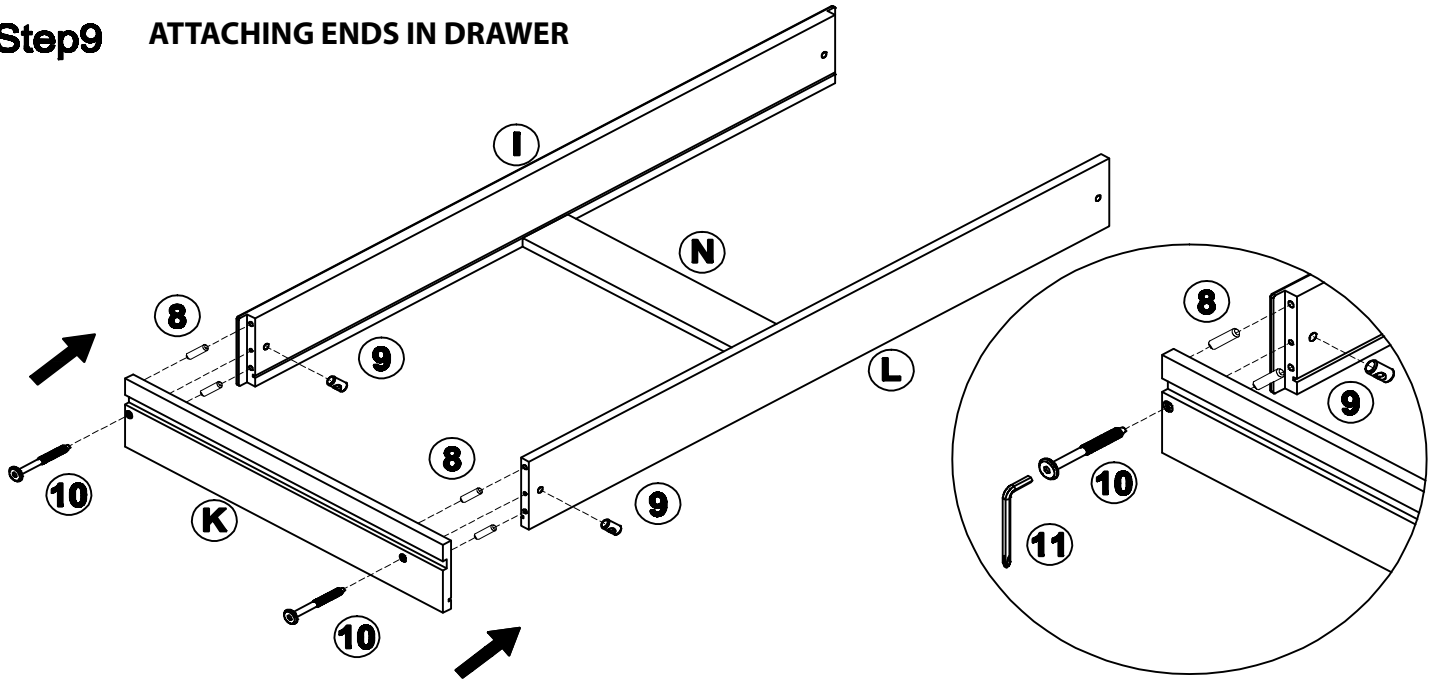
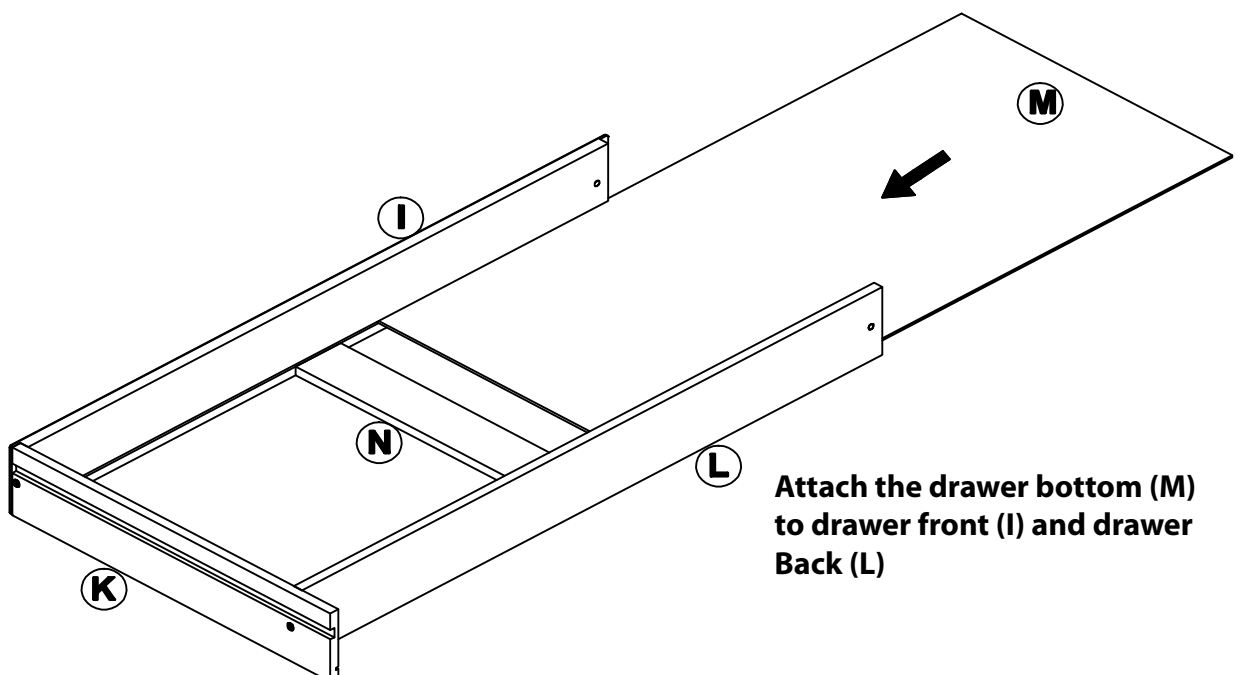

Step11 COMPLETING ASSEMBLY OF DRAWER

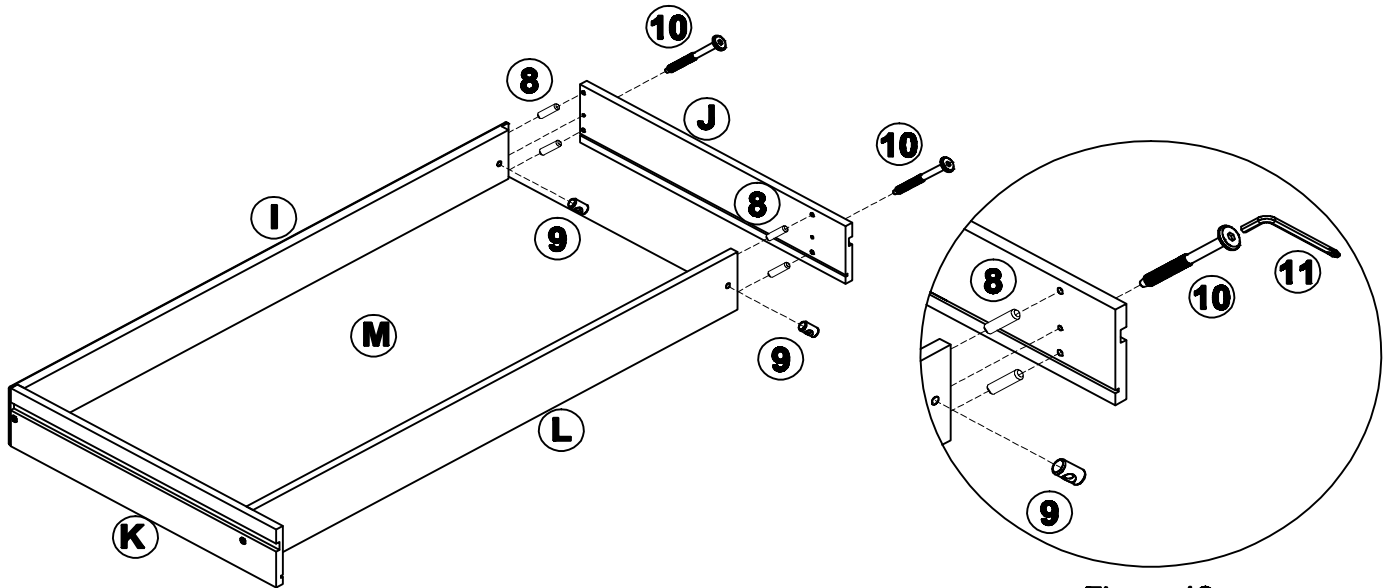
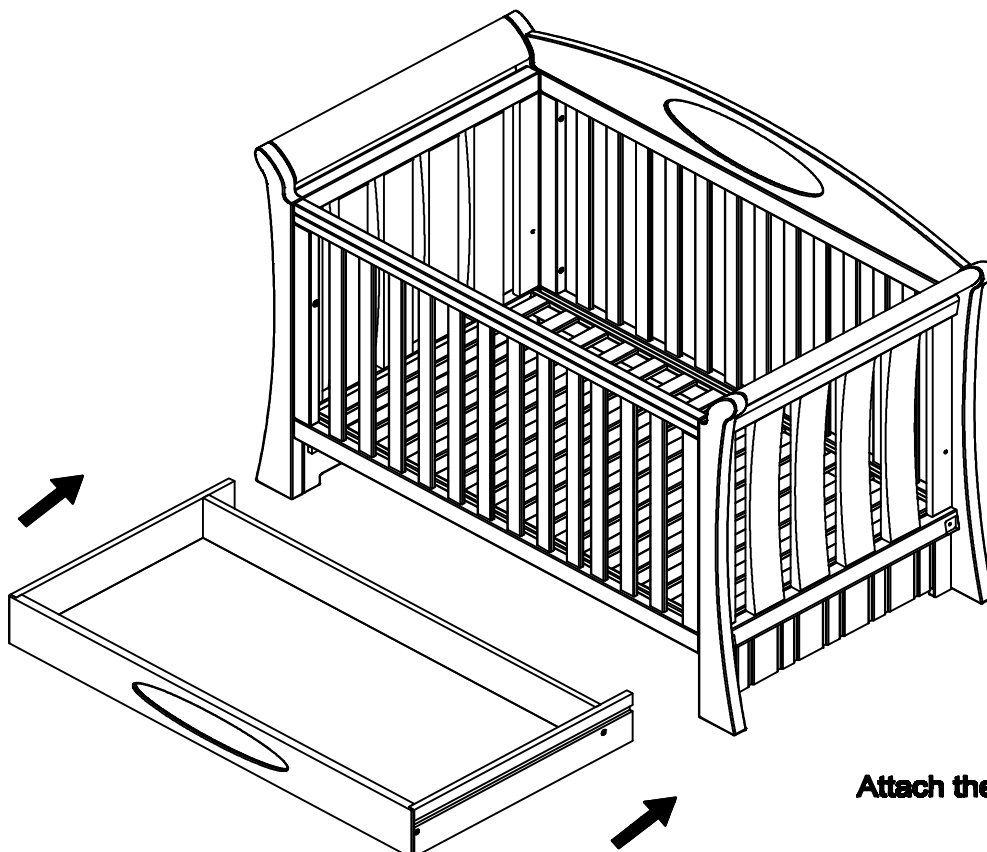

HOW TO ADJUST THE MATTRESS BASE

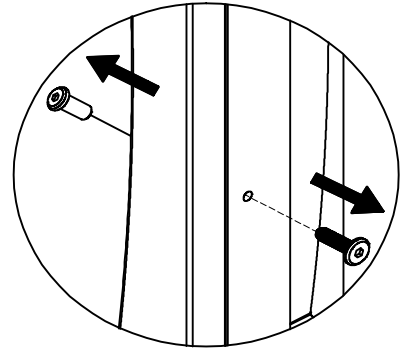
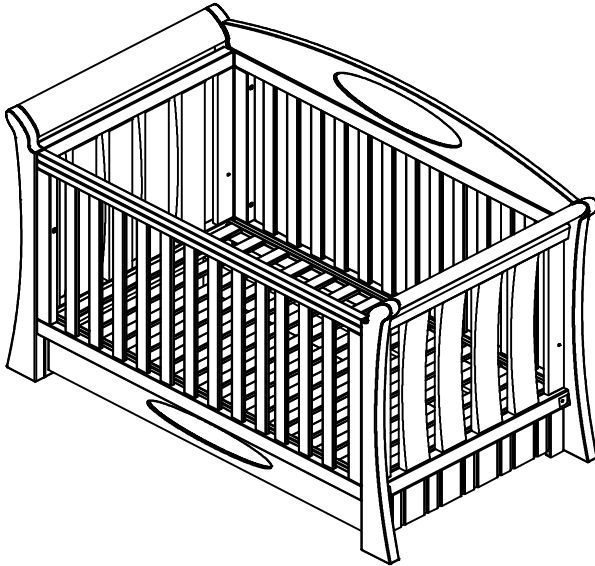

Raise the mattress base to the highest position. Turn out the bolts that are inside the holes. See Figure 13.

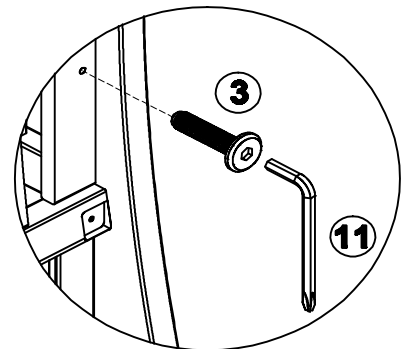
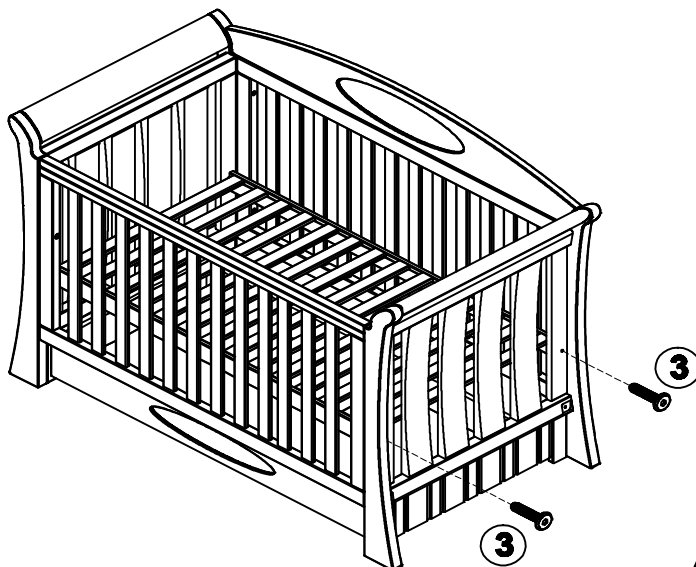
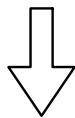

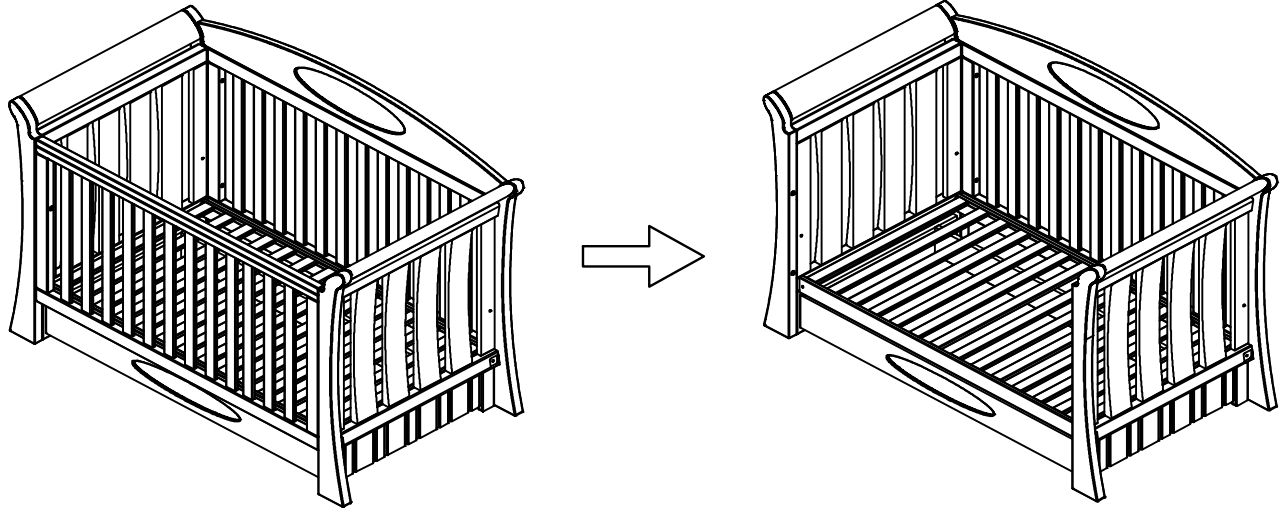
Attach 4pcs bolts (3) to Left & Right Sides See Figure 14.

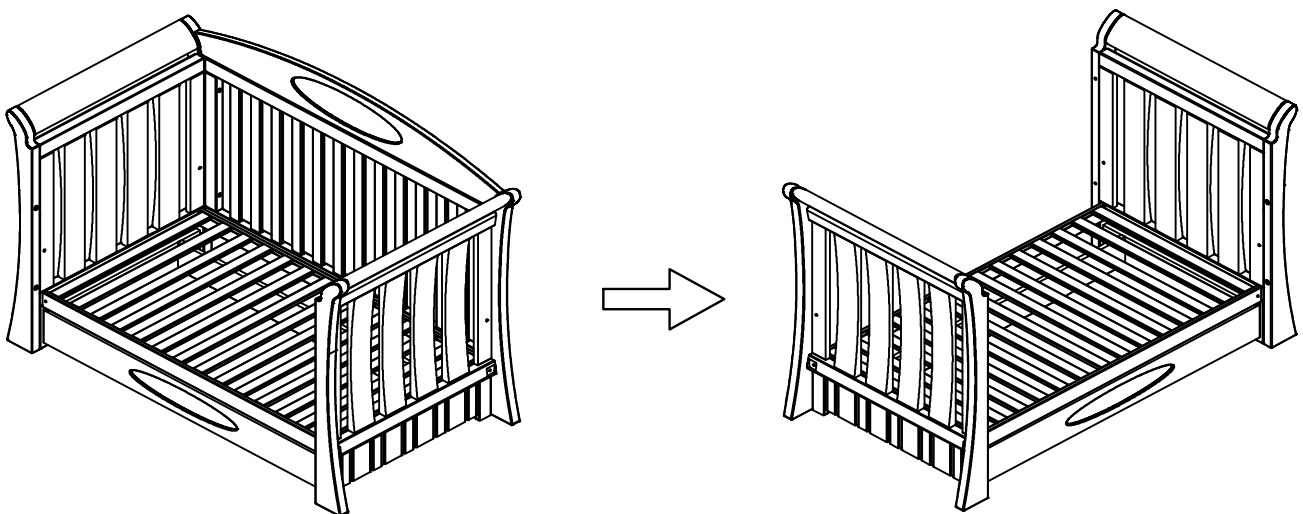
ASSEMBLY

TO CONVERT THE COT INTO A SOFA



Loose bolts in the Left & Right Sides. Remove the front drop side. Tighten the bolts.

TO CONVERT THE SOFA TO A TODDLER BED



Remove the back fixed side.
