







Safety guidelines and instructions must always be followed before making use of this product, please retain these instructions for future reference. This product complies with product standard: AS/NZS 2172:2003 Cots for household use - Safety Requirements

This cot has been designed for a child up to 25kg

Do not leave your child unattended when the dropside is in the lower position

RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE: This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measure 690mm wide by 1300mm long and 130mm in thickness.

The width and length are specific because it is important that the gaps between the mattress and the sides and ends of the cot will not exceed 40mm. This is to minimize the risk of a childs limb becoming caught in the gap. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than 500mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimise the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

WARNING TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MATTRESS BASE OF THIS COR SHOULD BE ADJUSTED TO THE LOWEST POSITION BEFORE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP.


The manufacturers assembly instructions must be followed in detail to ensure all the safety features of the cot are not compromised.

Please ensure that the cot is placed at a reasonable distance from curtains, blinds, heaters and power points.

Please keep medication, string, elastic, small toys or small items, such as money out of reach from any position in the cot.

WARNING: TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MAXIMUM MATTRESS THICKNESS SHOULD NOT EXCEED 130mm.


(A) COT END (LEFT)

(1) 1/4" x 2 1/2" (x12)





(2) 25mm (x4)


(4) Barrel Nut (x8)

OVE Care ASSEMBLY



ATTACH THE COT BASE TO THE COT END

1. Select the appropriate base position on being either upper or lower.


2. Insert the Barrel nuts (4) into each end of the base.3.When the base is being used in the upper position, use 4 (1) screws to attach the ends(A)(B) to the base (D). Make sure that it lines up with the barrel nuts.

4. Attach the 4 blank ends (2) and (3) on each side of the ends, on the lower side. The blank ends are 2 pieces that screw into each other.

5.When the base is being used in the lower position, use 4 (1) screws to attach the ends to the base. Make sure that it lines up with the barrel nuts.

6. Attach the 4 blank ends (2) and (3) on each side of the ends, on the upper side. The blank ends are 2 pieces that screw into each other.


Note: In this step do not tighten the bolts fully.



ATTACH THE FIXSIDE TO THE COT ENDS

7. Use 4 (1) screws to attach the Fixed side (C) to the cot ends (fig 2).

Note: In this step do not tighten the bolts fully.



ATTACHING THE DROP SIDE TO THE COT


8. Screw 4 (6) guide wheels into each of the front ends where the dropside is to be placed as shown in (fig 4)

9. Line the dropside against the 4 guide wheels. Ensure that they are joined as shown in (fig 4)

10. Use the 2 (7) screw sums to connect the dropside to the ends as shown in (fig 4).

11. You can now tighten the screws.

CONVERTING TO THE JUNIOR BED


(once assembled as a cot)

12. Remove the fixed side and the dropside from the cot.

13. Attach 4(4) Barrel nuts to each end of the bed rail sides (F)

14. Insert 4 (1) screws to each side of the ends so the bed rail will be assembled.

15. Tighten the screws.
