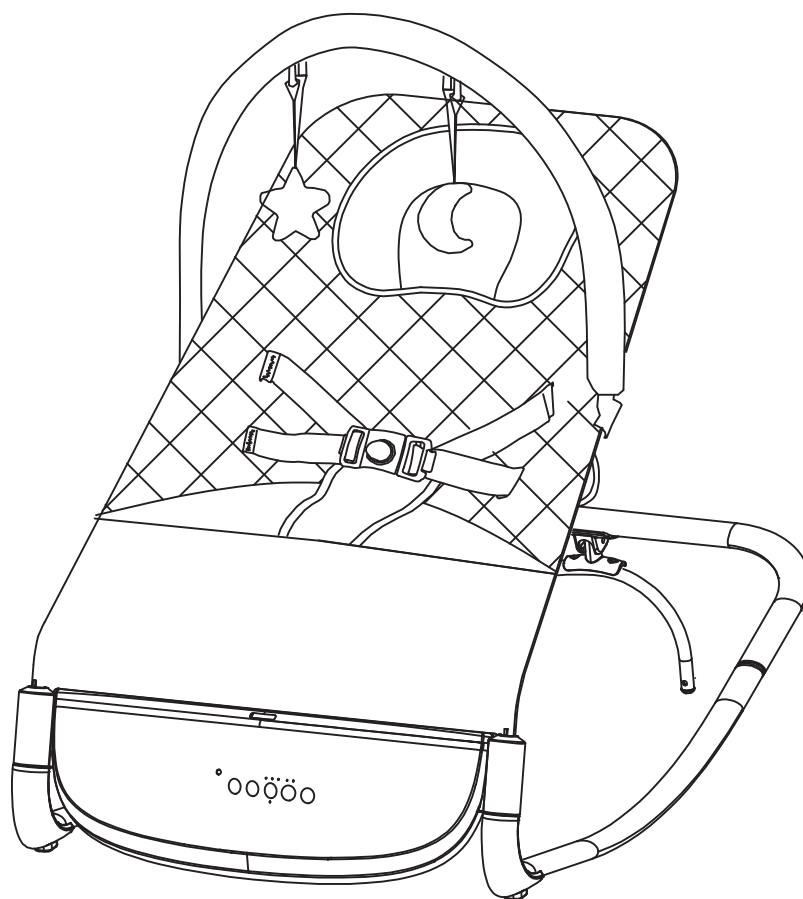

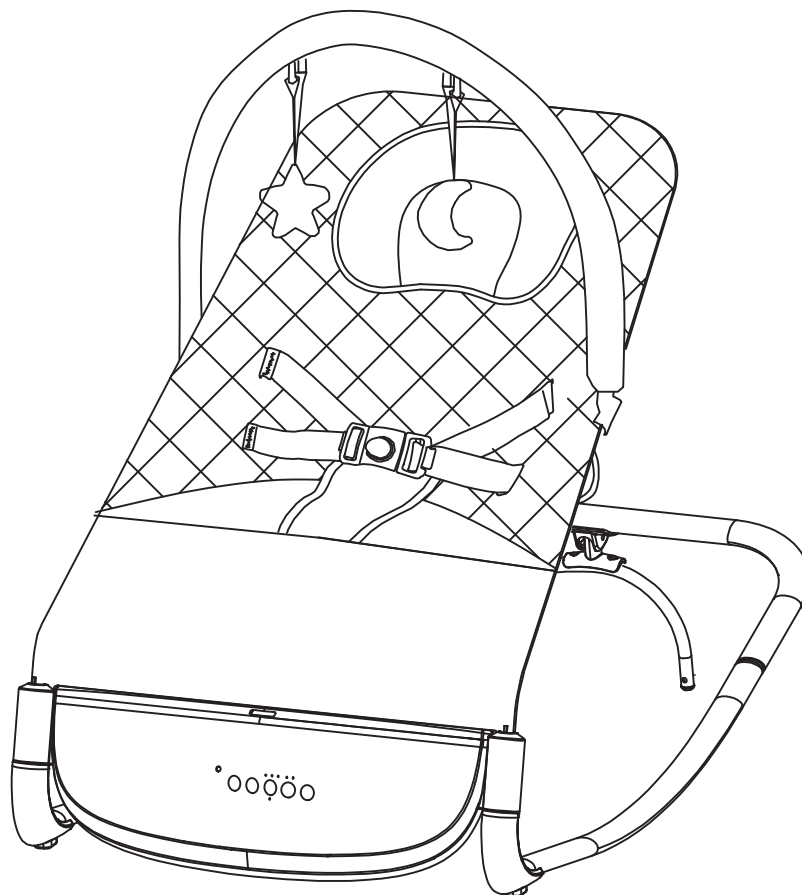

Congratulations on your purchase of the Auto Rocker. This product has been designed and developed with safety, comfort and functionality in mind. Please take the time to read this manual carefully before using this product and keep it in a safe place for future reference



WARNING

- Keep instructions for future use.
- Do not use this infant swing seat if it is damaged or broken.

FALL and STRANGULATION HAZARDS:

Infants have suffered head injuries falling from swings and have been strangled in straps.

- **Always** use restraints. Adjust to fit snugly.
- **STOP** using product when infant attempts to climb out (approximately 9 months) or the infant's weight reach to 12kg (26lbs), whichever comes first.
- Stay near and watch baby during use. This product is not safe for sleep or unsupervised use. If baby falls asleep, remove baby as soon as possible and place baby on a firm, flat sleep surface such as a crib or bassinet.

Battery Information

The rocker requires (4) size AA/LR6 (1.5V) alkaline batteries (Not included) .

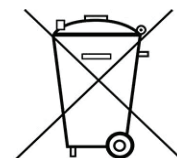

Assembly Instructions

Adult Assembly is required. Please follow these steps carefully.

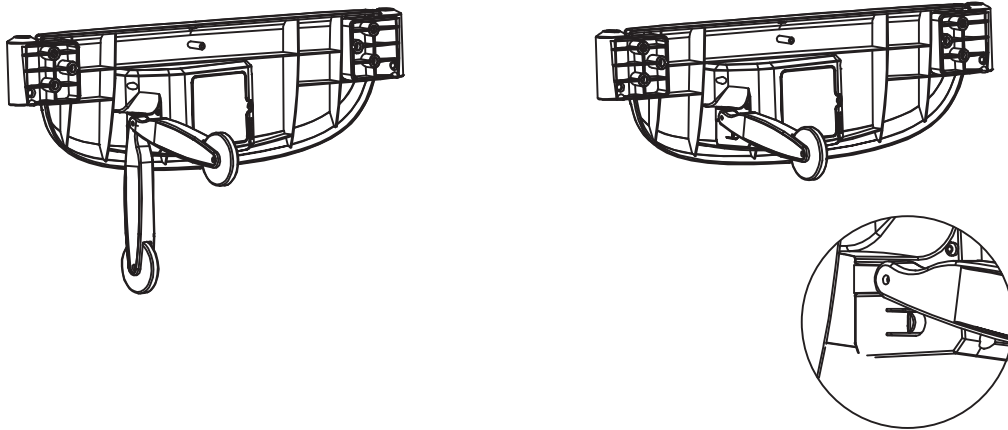
Step 1. Base Assembly

Place the rear base tube (6) on the ground. Insert the 2 front base tubes (5) into the rear base tube until the spring lock clicks into place. The base assembly is now complete.

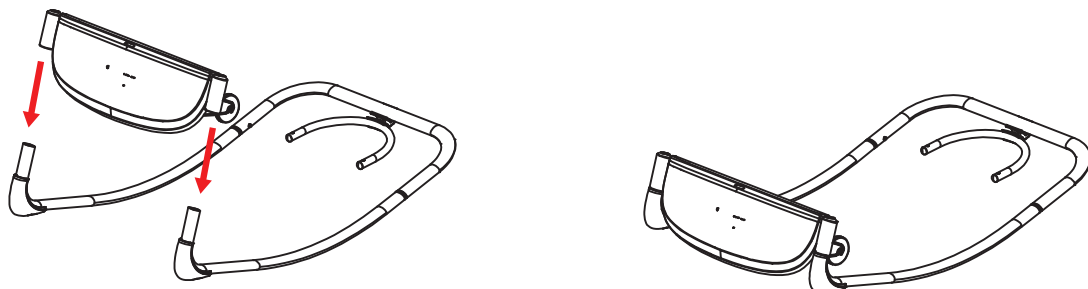


Step 2. Attaching the control Unit

Remove the Control unit (4), Lift up the Auto rocking arm located underneath the control unit.

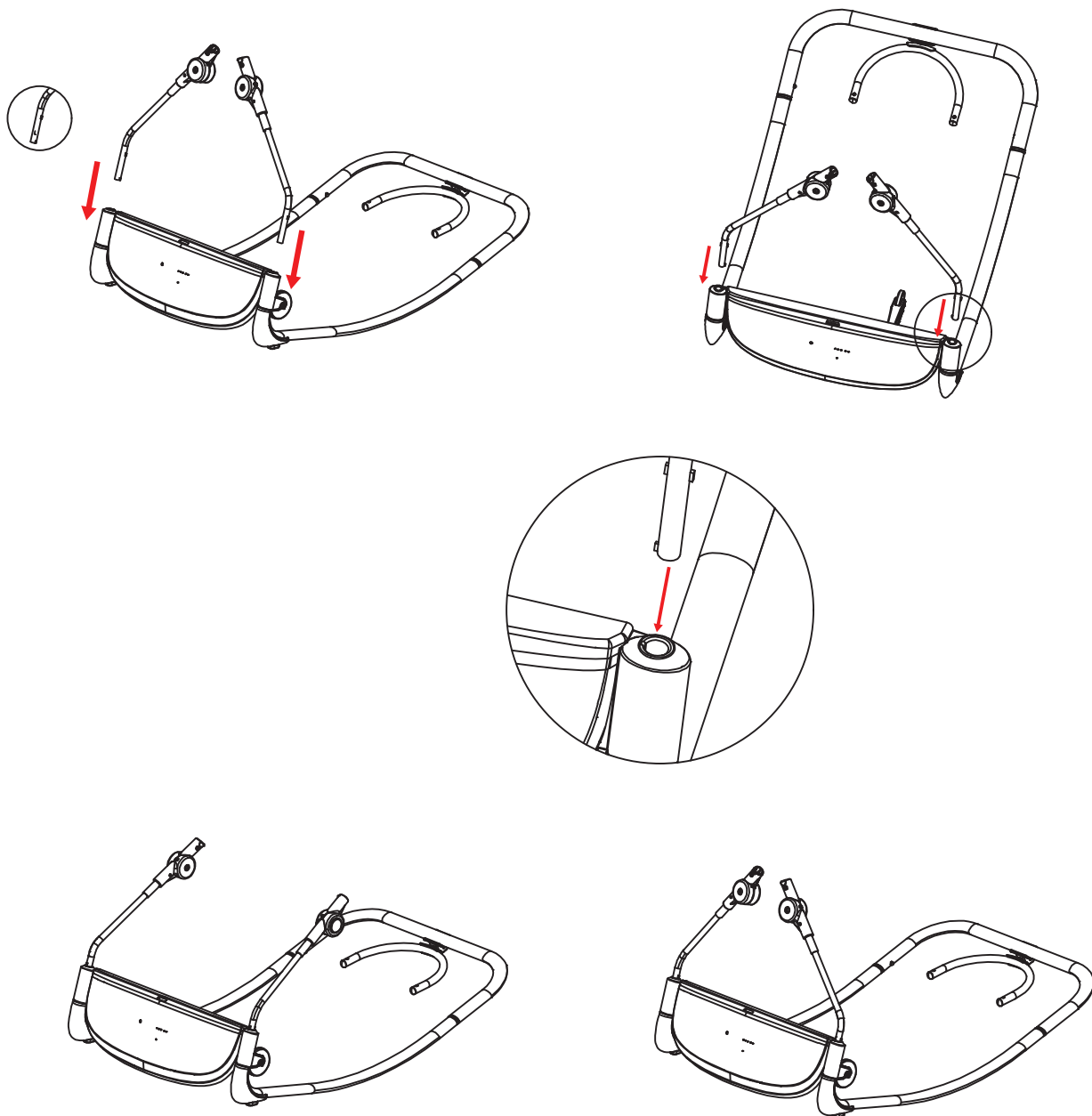


Place the assembled base on the floor, install the control unit (4) onto the base in the direction of the arrow until it clicks into place.



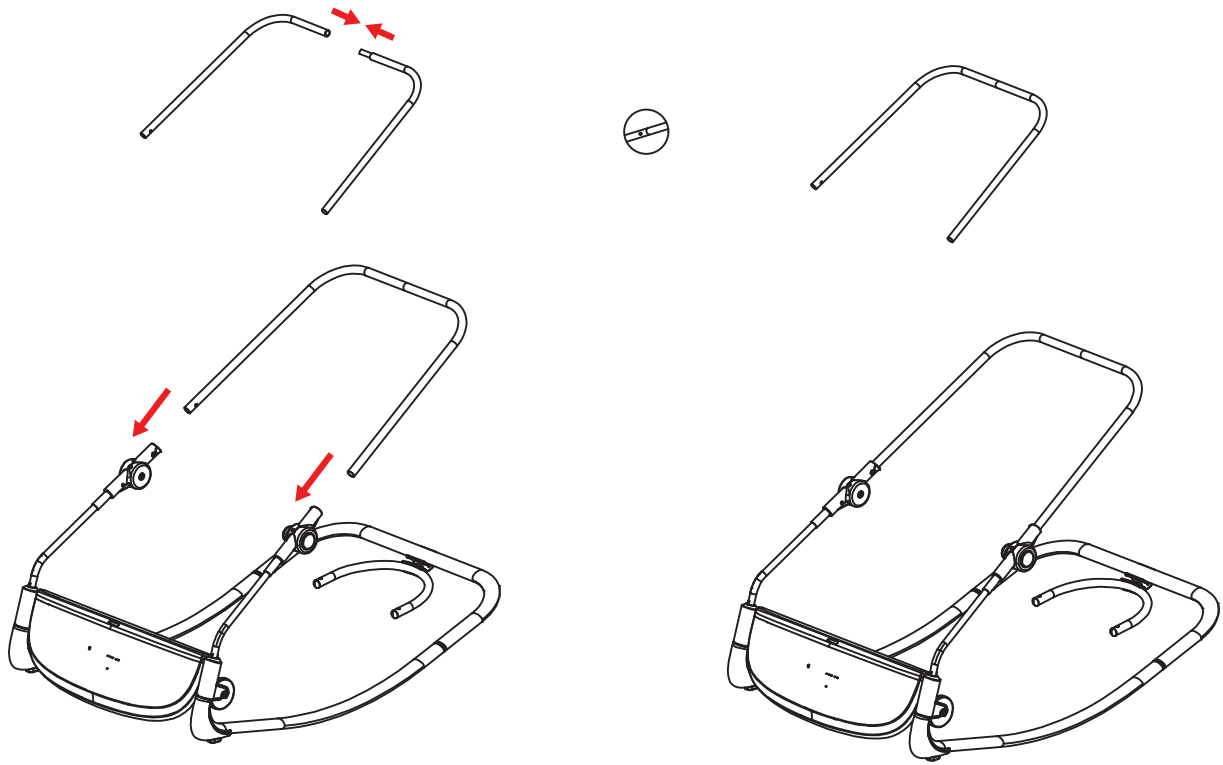
Step 3. Install the seat frame

Take the Metal seat frame (2), insert it into the slots on the control unit in the directions shown below. Ensure the protrusion on the seat frame aligns with the groove in the control units slot. Once inserted rotate the seat frame to lock it into place.



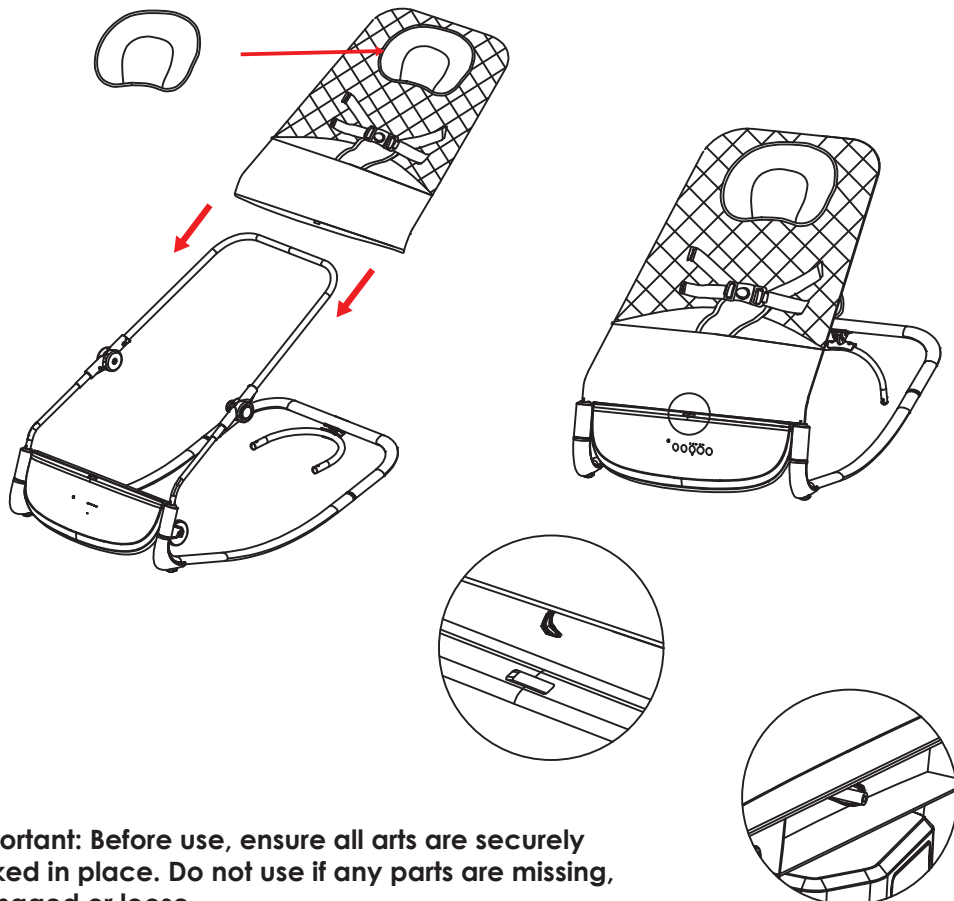
Step 4. Attaching the backrest

Connect the 2 backrest support tubes (1) together. Insert the connected tubes into the metal seat frame until the spring lock clicks.



Step 5. Attaching the Seat Pad

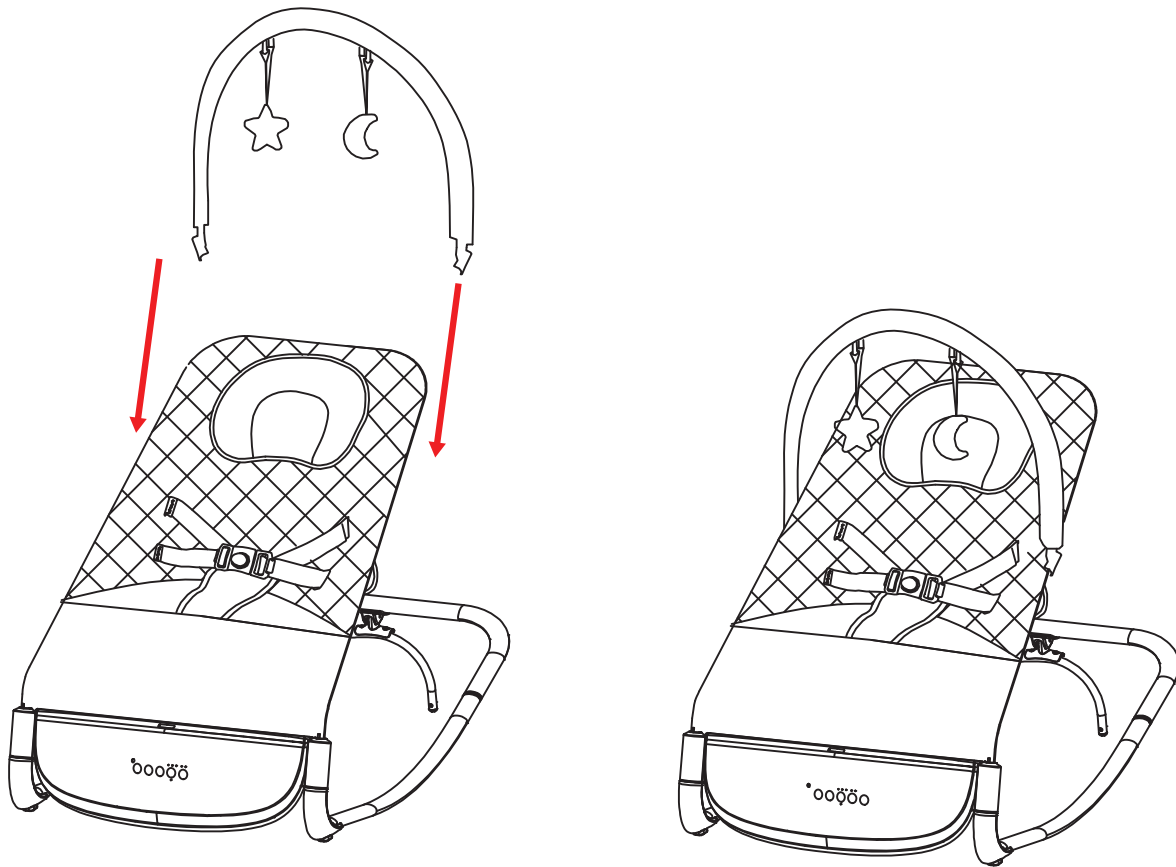
Place the pillow (7) on the seat pad. Drape the seat pad (8) over the assembled frame. Thread the strap at the bottom of the seat pad through the opening of the control unit and hook it onto the post at the back to secure.



Important: Before use, ensure all parts are securely locked in place. Do not use if any parts are missing, damaged or loose.

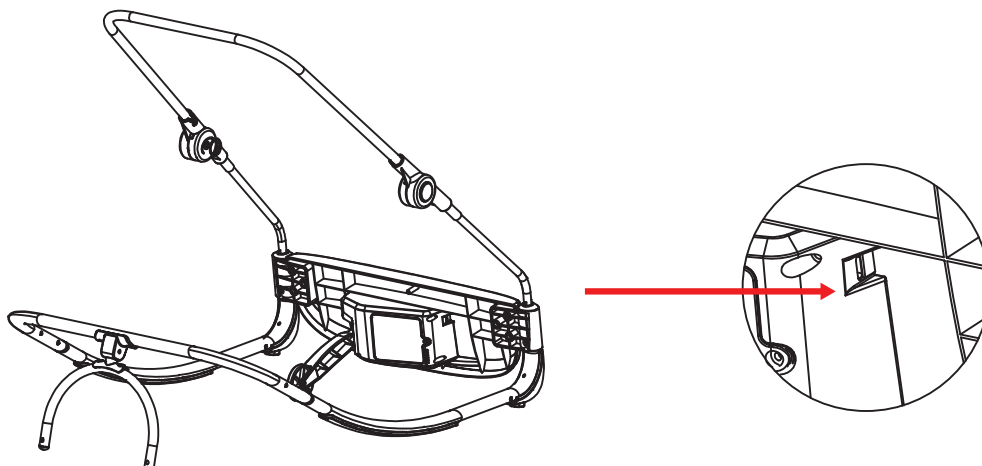
Step 6. Attaching the Toybar to the seat

Attach the toybar (3) to the side of the seat frame.



Power

Use a 5v Power adaptor (11). Plug the adaptor into a 110-240V outlet and connect the Type-C end to the port on the back of the control unit. For indoor use only.



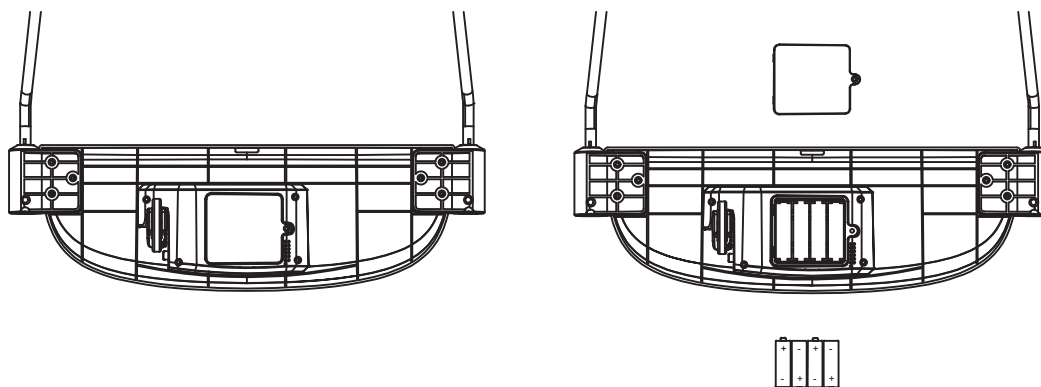
Using Batteries

Step 1: use a screwdriver to loosen and remove the screw on the battery compartment cover located on the back of the control unit.

Step 2: Install 4 AA batteries into the compartment, observing the correct polarity (+/-) as shown inside.

Step 3: Replace the cover and securely tighten the screw to complete the installation.

Remove all batteries for long-term storage to prevent leakage and damage.



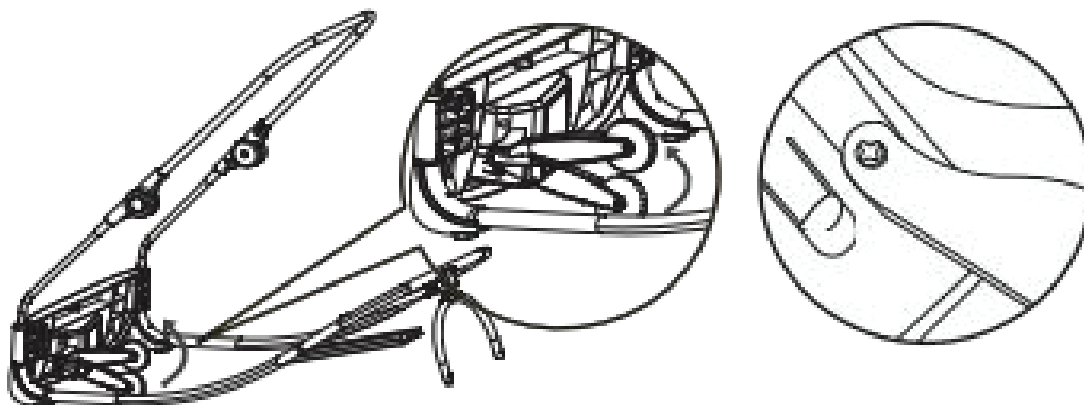
How to Use

Manual rocking Mode

Adjust the Auto rocking arm upwards until it locks into the higher position and no longer touches the floor. The kickstand remains folded up. You can rock the chair manually.



Caution/Warning: The Auto rocking mode is suitable only for children weighing up to 9kg. Please switch to manual mode if the child weighs more than 9kg.

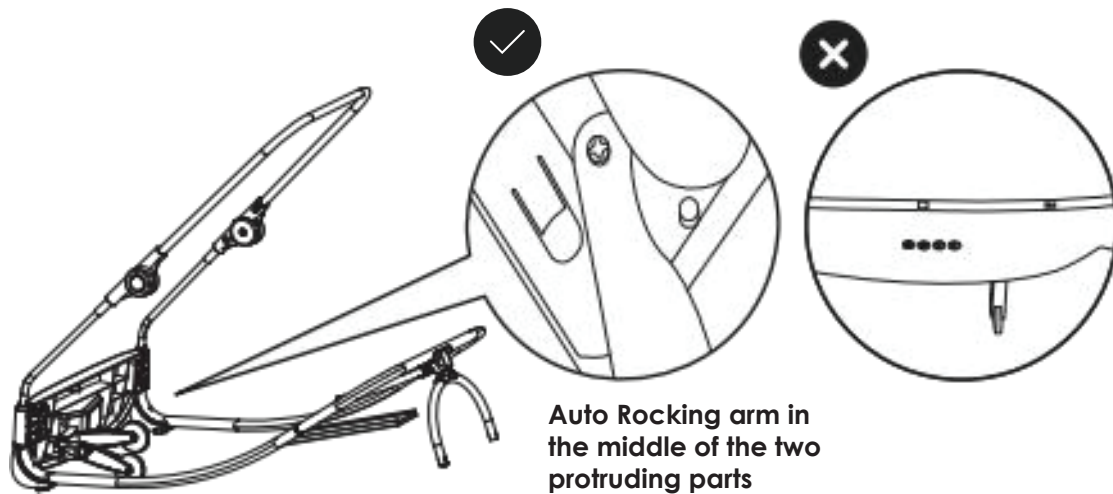
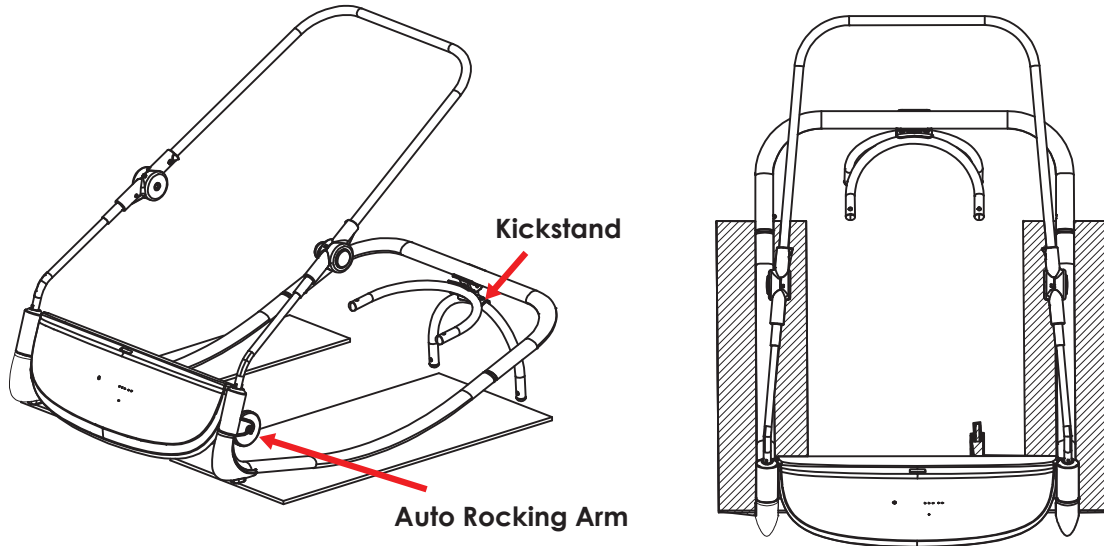


How to Use

Auto rocking Mode

Ensure the auto rocking arm is extended down to touch the floor.
Ensure the kickstand is folded up.

For shag carpet: Place the carpet stabilizer (9 and 10) (plastic board) underneath the rocker for better performance.

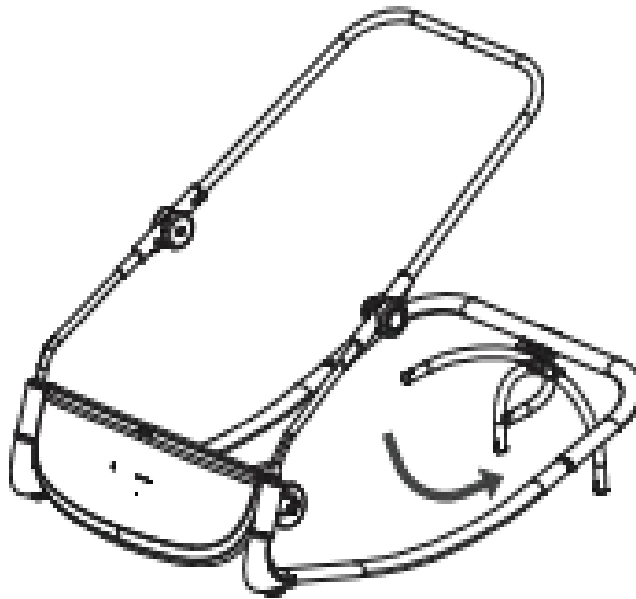


 **Caution/Warning:** Make sure to put the auto rocking arm in the right position before using the rocker.

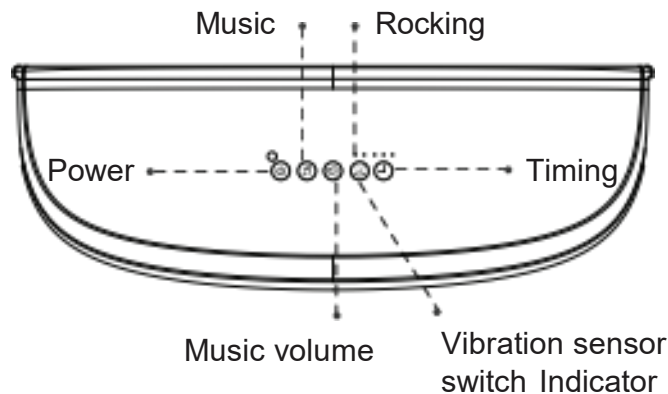
How to Use

Stationary Mode

Deploy the kickstand to lock the rocker in a static, non-rocking position.



Control Panel function



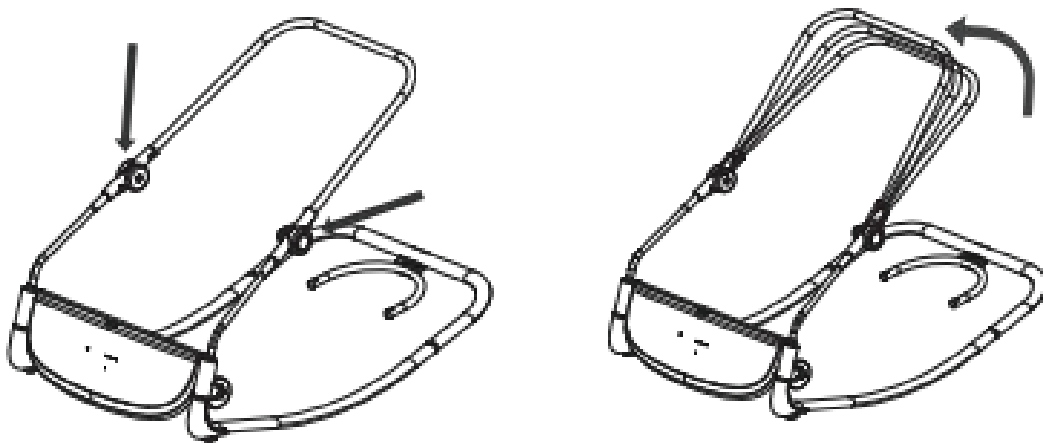
-  **Power Button** - Press to turn the unit on. You will hear a startup sound and the indicator lights will illuminate.
-  **Music** - Press to cycle through 8 soothing tracks. (3 calming nature sounds and 5 gentle music melodies)
While the music is playing press the button again to switch to the next track. Hold to turn the sound off.
-  **Music Volume** - Press to cycle through the volume levels (low > Medium > High)
-  **Rocking** - Press to start automatic rocking. There are three speed settings.
-  **Timing** - Press to set the auto-off timer (30 or 60 Minutes)

Motion Sensor

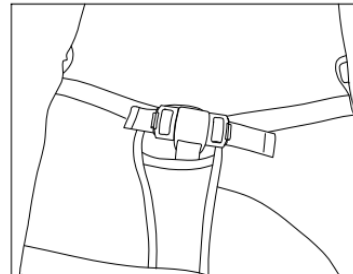
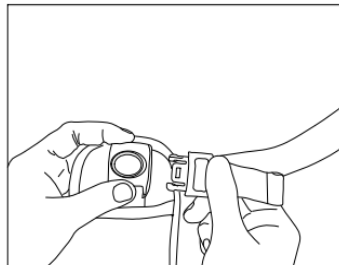
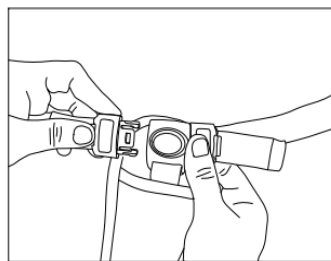
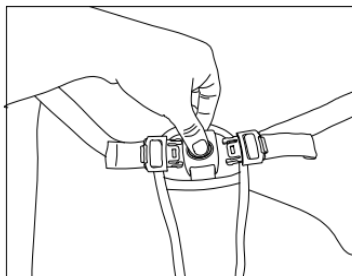
After startup, the vibration sensor function is enabled by default, and the vibration sensor indicator light remains on. At this time, when vibration is detected, the product automatically starts to rock, defaulting to the first rocking level. When rocking is manually activated, the motion control function is turned off, and the indicator light stays off

Adjusting the Backrest

Simultaneously press the adjustment buttons on both sides of the seat and move the backrest up or down. There are three recline positions



Using the Safety Harness



Releasing the Harness

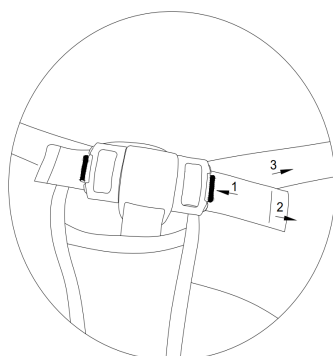
Press the Release Button: Locate the round button in the center of the main buckle housing.

Remove the Prongs: Press the button firmly while simultaneously pulling the waist strap prongs out and away from the central buckle.

Securing the Harness

Insert the Prongs: Take the plastic prongs attached to the waist straps and align them with the slots on either side of the central buckle housing (attached to the crotch strap).

Lock in Place: Push each prong firmly into the buckle until you hear a "click," ensuring both sides are securely fastened.



Adjusting the Strap Length

Refer to the circular diagram with the numbered arrows to adjust the fit:

To Tighten: Grip the loose tail end of the strap (indicated by Arrow 2) and pull it outward, away from the buckle.

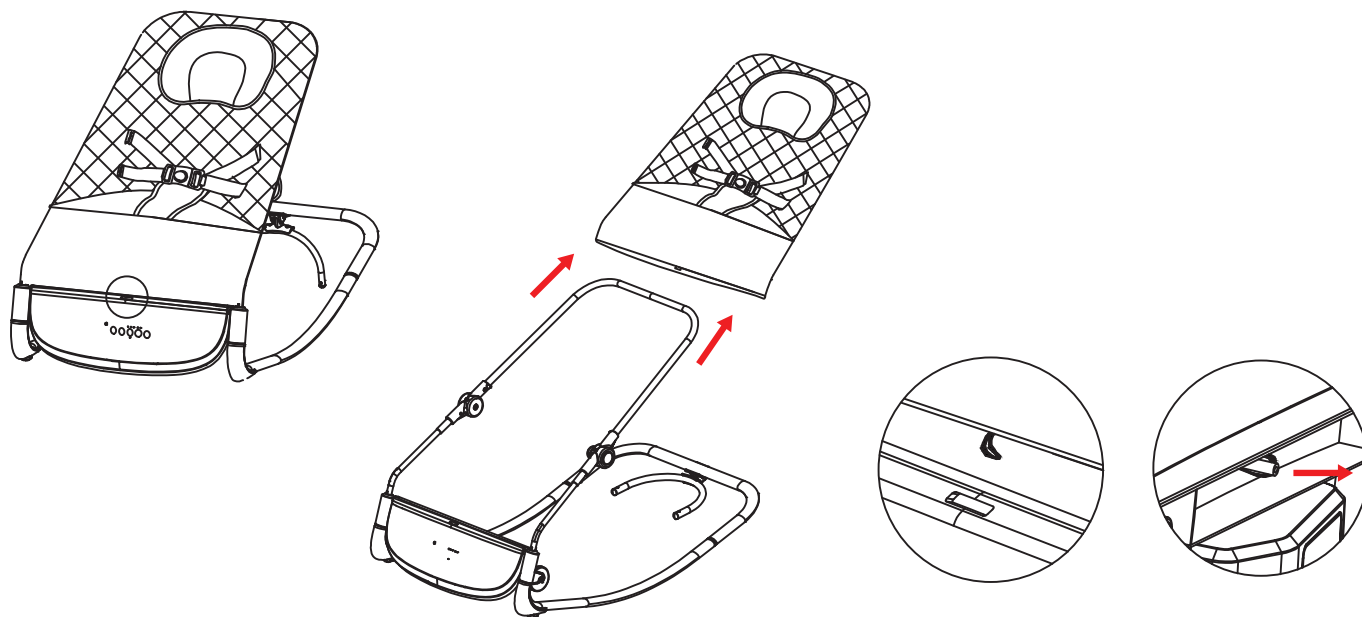
To Loosen: Grasp the main portion of the strap (indicated by Arrow 3) and pull it back through the buckle mechanism to create more slack.

Ensure Proper Fit: Adjust both sides until the harness is snug and comfortable.

Removing the Seat Pad for cleaning

Step 1: Detach the strap from the bottom of the seat pad from the control unit.

Step 2: Grasp both sides of the seat pad and slowly pull it upward to remove it from the frame.



6. Care & Maintenance

6.1 Cleaning

- **Seat Pad:** Remove from the frame. Machine wash in cold water on a gentle cycle. Do not use bleach. Tumble dry on low heat.
- **Frame & Control Unit:** Wipe with a soft, clean cloth dampened with mild soap and water. Do not immerse in water.

6.2 Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause & Solution
No music or rocking	Batteries are low or exhausted. Replace all 4 AA batteries.
Weak rocking	Batteries are low. Replace all 4 AA batteries.
Product does not turn on	Check battery polarity. Ensure all connectors are secure after assembly.
For long-term storage	Remove all batteries from the compartment.

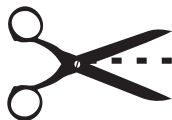
